~~This is~~ a Selected Subject bibliography concerning the various aspects of counterinsurgency and unconventional warfare. For the most part, the items cited have been published recently.^{1/} Sometimes not so recent items are included when any of the subject categories are exceptionally weak. While individuals may find many different uses for this bibliography, it is designed primarily for individual study and unit training.

The majority of the items in this bibliography are available in average-sized Service libraries and in many of the larger public libraries. Items not available in a given library can often be obtained through inter-library loan.

A serious study of available historical works should engender the formulation of a realistic and flexible doctrine of operations.
