SUBJECT: Ethics Review for Poster

1. Capt Douglas B. Walton, the primary author, submitted a request for a legal review of a poster he plans to present at a professional society meeting. The poster is titled "A Case of Epidermal Nevus Syndrome with a Novel Association of Congenital Cystic Dysplastic Kidney with Numerous Nephroblastic Proliferations." Capt Walton plans to demonstrate the poster at the College of American Pathologists Annual Meeting in Las Vegas, Nevada on 25-28 September 2016. The abstract submitted included the required disclaimer discussed below. A Public Affairs review will be required if it has not already been obtained. There are no conflict of interest issues with demonstration of the poster at the above-mentioned forum.

2. FACTS: Capt Walton plans to demonstrate the poster titled "A Case of Epidermal Nevus Syndrome with a Novel Association of Congenital Cystic Dysplastic Kidney with Numerous Nephroblastic Proliferations" at the College of American Pathologists Annual Meeting.

3. LAWS AND REGULATIONS: DoD 5500.07-R, Joint Ethics Regulation (JER), section 3-305 lays out rules governing "Teaching, Speaking and Writing." If the publication will "deal in significant part with any ongoing or announced policy, program or operation" of the Air Force, the author is required to include a disclaimer that states the "views presented are those of the speaker or author and do not necessarily represent the views of DoD or its Components."

4. ANALYSIS: The poster does not "deal in significant part with any ongoing or announced policy, program or operation" of the Air Force; however, the presenter's affiliation with the military will be included in the presentation. Therefore, the authors included the required disclaimer that the views presented are those of the authors and do not necessarily represent the views of DoD or its Components on the abstract submitted for review. Although the disclaimer language included on the abstract is not verbatim from the JER, the language used is appropriate and clearly captures the intent of the language used in the JER. A Public Affairs review will be needed if it has not already been obtained. There are no apparent conflicts of interest that would prohibit demonstration of the poster.

5. CONCLUSIONS: The abstract for review included the disclaimer required by the JER. The disclaimer must be also be included on the poster. There are no conflicts of interest.

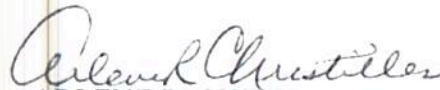

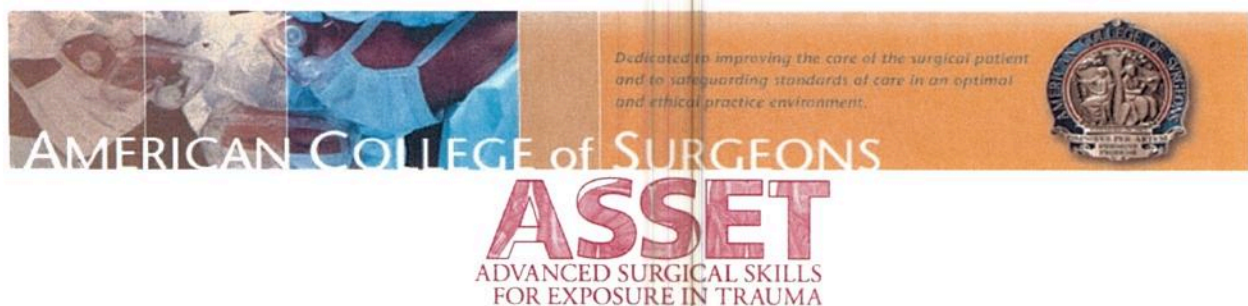

A Case of Epidermal Nevus Syndrome with a Novel Association of Congenital Cystic Dysplastic Kidney with Numerous Nephroblastic Proliferations

Epidermal nevus syndrome is a broad term encompassing several disease processes. These entities are united by their association with epidermal nevi and extracutaneous abnormalities. Renal aberrancies associated with this syndrome include nephroblastoma, hamartomas, hypoplasia, and renal agenesis. However, there are no well-described, documented cases of dysplastic kidney with cystic nephroblastic proliferation associated with epidermal nevus syndrome. We present a unique case of a female neonate with a medical history significant for seizure-like activity, a hyperplastic thyroid nodule, aortic coarctation, patent ductus arteriosus, and epidermal nevus syndrome. On the third day of life the patient had an abdominal ultrasound that demonstrated an enlarged left kidney predominately replaced by small cysts with intervening echogenic tissue. Pre-operative considerations included nephroblastoma, congenital mesoblastic nephroma, and dysplastic kidney. On gross examination following nephrectomy, the capsular surface was covered by small clear fluid-filled cysts ranging in size from 0.1 cm to 0.8 cm in diameter. Sectioning of the kidney revealed multicystic and unicystic areas with intervening renal parenchyma. Histologically, the cysts were lined by cuboidal epithelium with associated nests of nephroblastic epithelium that projected into the cystic lumina and were present in the intervening parenchyma (Figure). This epithelium is comprised of crowded cells with a high nuclear to cytoplasm ratio, nuclear molding, and dispersed chromatin with occasional nucleoli. Lesional cells were immunoreactive for WT-1. The histologic appearance was concerning for cystic nephroblastoma but expert opinions favored dysplastic cysts with nephroblastic proliferations. At fourteen months post-operative follow-up the patient is well with appropriate development for age.
