TRADOC Operations Reporting

Summary. This change to TRADOC Reg 1-8, 13 Nov 01, includes specific heat and cold injuries that warrant reporting to HQ TRADOC.

Applicability. This regulation applies to HQ TRADOC, and to all TRADOC commands, schools, and activities.

Supplementation. Supplementation of this regulation is not authorized.

Suggested Improvements. The proponent of this regulation is the Deputy Chief of Staff for Operations and Training (DCSOPS&T). 1. Change TRADOC Reg 1-8, 13 Nov 01, as follows:

Paragraph 2-2a(2). Add after first sentence: "A confirmed case of heat stroke, hypothermia, or frostbite is considered a serious injury for the purpose of this regulation."
