## APPENDIX L

### COMPARISON OF THE TASK LIST FOR THE DECCUS STUDY (DECCUS) AND THE DOD-MODIFIED ADA TASK LIST (PROPOSED)

The DECCUS task codes and the DOD-modified task codes are both divided into sections according to the types of dental tasks they represent. For ease of understanding this discussion will address each type of dental procedure under a separate heading. The DECCUS tasks and the DOD-ADA tasks are numbered similarly, except that the DECCUS numbers contain three digits whereas the DOD-ADA numbers have five digits.

As the reader will note, the careful analysis of the two tasks lists made it quite clear that it is not possible to use them interchangeably. It is also clear that they could not be convertible one to the other, using automated equipment, because of the fundamentally different approach which was taken in the formulation of the two task lists.

#### Diagnostic Services 001-019 (DECCUS); 00100-00999 (DOD-ADA)

The DOD-ADA listing for examinations is quite detailed. It includes items such as the screening exam and written consultation which are not in the DECCUS list. The DECCUS listing of Diagnostic tasks however includes about six items which are performed rather frequently but are not on the DOD-ADA list. These include taking medical-dental history; consultations; oral health index; and evaluate treatment by auxiliaries. Because of these differences it would be very difficult if not impossible to give DOD-ADA codes to the DECCUS tasks.

#### Radiographs 020-029 (DECCUS); 00200-00399 (DOD-ADA)

The DOD-ADA listing includes a separate code for an Intraoral Series. Both the DOD-ADA and the DECCUS listings have codes for single intraoral and extraoral films. These are sufficient for military service needs. The DECCUS list does not have a code for a cephalometric film; the DOD-ADA list does. This code should be considered for inclusion in the DECCUS list. Generally speaking the two lists are comparable in this category.

#### Tests (and Laboratory Examination) 031-039 (DECCUS); 00400-00471 (DOD-ADA)

These tasks are roughly comparable on the two task lists, however the DECCUS list contains several items for which there are not comparable DOD-ADA codes. To make the two lists compatible either or both would have to be expanded.

Preventive 101-119 (DECCUS); 01000-01999 (DOD-ADA)

In the DOD-ADA list a dental prophylaxis has two code numbers, one for adult and one for child. Since the military does not charge patients this distinction is not necessary. The DOD-ADA list has no code for a scaling except as a periodontal treatment. In the DECCUS listing a scaling appears in both sections, as seems appropriate. Dietary planning is included under Preventive in the DOD-ADA list and under Diagnostic in the DECCUS list. For the above reasons it would be most difficult to apply DECCUS numbers to the DOD-ADA tasks or vice versa.

RESTORATIVE 201-299 (DECCUS); 02000-02999 (DOD-ADA)

This section of the DOD-ADA listing seems to be particularly inapplicable to the military situation. It lists types of restorations by material and number of surfaces involved, rather than listing the many tasks which are done to achieve the end result, as does the DECCUS list. It is very difficult to accurately apply the DOD-ADA code numbers to the DECCUS tasks (and vice versa) because of the fundamentally different approach taken in formulating them.

ENDODONTICS 301-399 (DECCUS); 03000-03999 (DOD-ADA)

The DOD-ADA listing has separate codes for a pulpotomy done on adult and deciduous teeth. It has two separate codes for an apicoectomy, depending upon whether or not it is done in conjunction with a root canal filling. The DOD-ADA listing has a number of codes for root canal fillings, discriminating between permanent and deciduous teeth and also on the basis of anterior, premolar, or molar teeth (adult). These numerous individual codes for similar tasks do not seem to be necessary for military services' reporting, particularly in the case of root canals, where they are credited by the number of canals filled, not by the number or type of tooth so treated.

The DOD-ADA listing has only one code for interim endodontic treatments. The DECCUS approach is more descriptive and precise because it has a separate code for each specific task such as enlarging the canal or placing a medicated dressing. These task codes, properly weighted and reported, would more accurately account for a providers' time than would one non-specific task code.

There are three items in the DOD-ADA list which are not in the DECCUS list and should be considered for inclusion. They are: apexification, retrograde filling; and endodontic implant.

Periodontics 401-499 (DECCUS); 04000-04999 (DOD-ADA)

The DECCUS list is more specific than the DOD-ADA listing so it would be difficult to make the code numbers interchangeable or convertible. There are several tasks in the DOD-ADA list which should be considered for inclusion in the DECCUS list. They are: distal wedge procedure; osseous graft; gingivitis treatment; and the specification of occlusal adjustment as limited or complete.

Prosthodontics, Removable 501-599 (DECCUS); 05000-05999 (DOD-ADA)

The DOD-ADA list includes none of the preliminary or interim procedures which are a large part of a prosthodontic service. The list contains only products such as various types of complete and partial dentures, duplicate and relined dentures, overdentures, etc. The DOD-ADA listing would not allow the military clinician to take credit for any procedures until the final product was delivered to the patient. It does not even mention impressions. There appears to be no way to make the DECCUS and DOD-ADA listings comparable or interchangeable. If the military services are interested only in final products then the DOD-ADA codes might be useful. However, they would not reflect most of what the prosthodontist did during much of his/her productive time.

There are, however, several items in the DOD-ADA list which should be considered for inclusion in the DECCUS list. They are: corrected (altered) cast impression; maxillofacial appliances including obturator; nose, ear, eye, and finger prostheses; all-resin removable partial dentures; immediate denture; and possibly overdentures or coping dentures.

Prosthodontics, Fixed 701-799 (DECCUS); 06000-06999 (DOD-ADA)

As with removable prosthodontics, the DOD-ADA list of tasks lists essentially final products and none of the preparatory and interim procedures which lead up to the final product. An exception is the stain and glaze procedure (06611) which should be added to the DECCUS list. The DOD-ADA task list includes various types of crowns and fixed partial dentures according to material, veneers, and connectors, detail which is not necessary for reporting purposes in the military system.

Oral Surgery 901-999 (DECCUS); 07000-07999 (DOD-ADA)

In some respects the DOD-ADA list has more detail than the DECCUS list. It gives separate codes for removal of an odontogenic and for a non-odontogenic cyst or tumor. There are codes for both complicated and uncomplicated stomatoplasty. Since oral surgeons perform a great variety of procedures, some consideration might be given to combining the DECCUS and the DOD-ADA lists, taking care not to duplicate tasks. As now constructed it would be very difficult to apply the DOD-ADA codes to the DECCUS tasks because of the differences in the manner in which each list breaks down certain surgical procedures.

Orthodontics 801-899 (DECCUS); 08000-08999 (DOD-ADA)

Though the DOD-ADA listing does include some preparatory and post-insertion tasks such as banding, bonding brackets, adjustments, and band removal, it is not as detailed in this respect as is the DECCUS list. The DOD-ADA listing is primarily concerned with the product or appliance provided to the patient such as various types of habit breakers, active or interceptive appliances, removable or fixed appliances, etc. If military orthodontists feel that this approach is necessary, consideration could be given to integrating some of this detail into the DECCUS list. But the DECCUS list is quite inclusive as to the various types of orthodontic appliances as well as the many different tasks performed in the course of active and passive orthodontic care. The DOD-ADA listing does not include many of the latter. Consequently it would not allow the military orthodontist to account for much of his productive time.

Adjunctive General Services 601-699 (DECCUS); 09000-09999 (DOD-ADA)

This section is more inclusive in the DOD-ADA list and there are a number of items which should be considered for inclusion in the DECCUS list. The DOD-ADA listing gives credit for the administration of local anesthesia for definitive dental care as well as the administration of local anesthesia for diagnostic purposes. DECCUS includes neither. The DOD-ADA list has four different codes for the administration of analgesia, whereas DECCUS has just one. The DOD-ADA list has a code for grand rounds. DECCUS just credits ward rounds. Oral surgeons would like both of the latter. The DOD-ADA list has a code for Post-Operative Treatment (other than post-surgical) which can be used for such tasks as denture adjustments, occlusion adjustments on new restorations, etc. This might also be considered for the DECCUS list under General Services.

## DECCUS - DOD/ADA Task Code Number Comparisons

Below in tabular form, is the list of Task Codes used in the DECCUS study. Alongside the tasks, where applicable, is the ADA code number for that task, as modified for the proposed DOD reporting system. It can be noted that there are many DECCUS tasks to which DOD-ADA code numbers cannot be applied. The reader will also note that there are some DECCUS tasks to which several DOD-ADA code numbers can be applied, although the match is not perfect because of the manner in which the ADA codes were derived. The ADA codes specify such things as whether a task was performed on an adult or child; whether a denture is maxillary or mandibular, and the material or material combinations used in partial dentures. Much of this specificity is not generally considered to be useful for reporting purposes by the military services and as such it is unnecessary detail.
