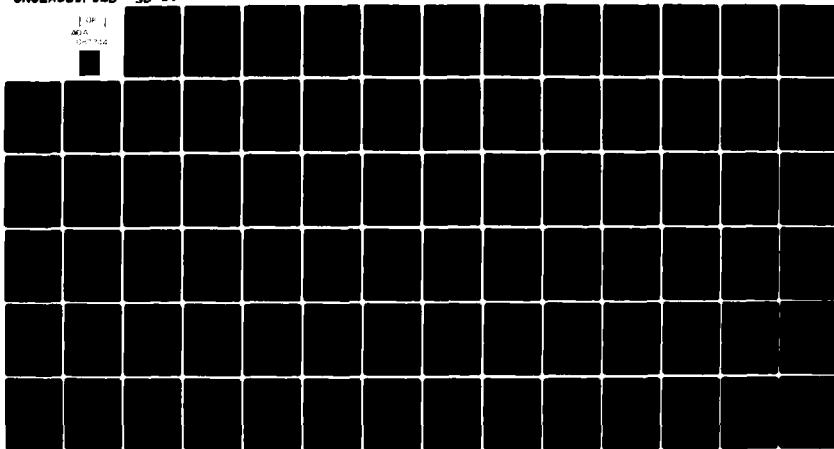

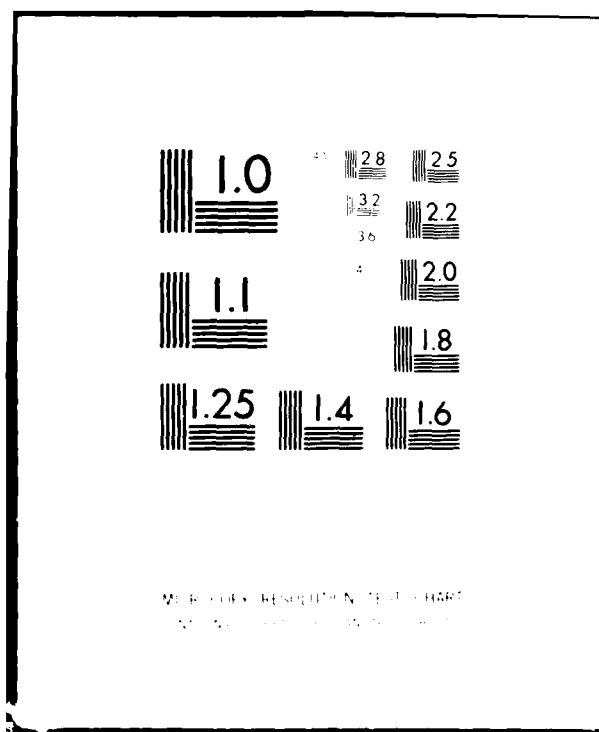

FOREWORD

This bibliography covers 741 rare titles owned by the Morris Swett Library. They are physically housed in the librarian's office and are available for use on the premises. The various items are shown in the card catalog by author/subject(s)/title. Following the Library of Congress call number, the entry "rare book" is shown on the card. The entry is also shown on the book's spine. This is to indicate that they have physically been extracted from circulation channels. As is the case with any aged, well-developed collection, many other volumes should also be set apart to guarantee their being available for further reference or research use. Criteria for inclusion on this list includes several factors. Market value, i.e., replacement cost, comprehensiveness or uniqueness of content, general treatment of the subject, author, and scarcity of required materials immediately come to mind.

Arrangement of this revised number is in three parts. Part one constitutes the list, arranged by call number, with subjects added. Part two provides some additional data, including price range on the used out-of-print market, if known. Most original manuscripts or non-copyrighted materials do not normally appear in the guides. Part three provides a cross reference to materials in the bibliography by number.

Inclusion of an item, or omission, does not imply USAFAS indorsement or sanction of the compiler's point-of-view. Neither does it guarantee accuracy of content. Comment and criticism concerning this list is solicited. Kudos are extended to Mrs. Linda L. Marburger for her assistance on this project.
