Fiscal Year 1979

BACKGROUND

This report presents the distribution of defense prime contract awards over \$10,000 in Labor Surplus Areas (LSA) for fiscal year 1979. These data include DoD prime contracts over \$10,000 awarded to U.S. business firms, educational and nonprofit institutions, and Government agencies, including Foreign Military Sales located in those areas designated labor surplus by the U.S. Department of Labor.

The Department of Labor has the responsibility for defining LSA's and for establishing eligibility criteria. The eligible areas are contained in their quarterly publication "Area Trends in Employment and Unemployment."

Prior to January 1, 1978, an area's eligibility was based on a fixed cutoff of a local unemployment rate of six percent or more. An area is now classified as labor surplus if its unemployment rate is 1.20 times the national rate. In addition, the eligibility criteria of LSA's include a lower and upper cutoff. All areas must have at least a six percent unemployment rate to qualify and any area with a jobless rate of 10 percent or more will automatically qualify. During fiscal 1979 the eligibility status of labor surplus areas was determined on an annual basis (rather than quarterly) and will be effective each June 1 and remain in effect for the following twelve months.

Also beginning in January 1978, the Department of Labor modified its definitions of area classifications by eliminating the terms "Areas of Substantial or Persistent Unemployment," "Sections of Concentrated Unemployment or Underemployment," and "Major and Smaller Areas." During fiscal year 1979 the Department of Labor revised the classification criteria for defining labor surplus areas as civil jurisdictions rather than labor market areas.

This report consists of seven tables (three summary tables and four tables showing awards by LSA for fiscal year 1979). Table 1A shows total procurement, total LSA procurement, and total preference awards for fiscal year 1979. Table 1B depicts the same data for fiscal years 1975 through 1978. Table 2 presents all LSA awards to U.S. business firms by type of set-aside preference. Table 3 shows all awards, by awarding department in Labor Surplus Areas. Table 4 displays this data as awarded by set-aside preference. Table 5 depicts that portion of Table 3 awarded by combined labor surplus/small business set-aside preference. Table 6 presents total awards in Labor Surplus Areas by tie-bid preference.

HIGHLIGHTS

In fiscal year 1979 defense prime contract awards over \$10,000 in LSA's totaled \$18,988 million or 31.1 percent of total awards compared to 45.4 percent in fiscal year 1978. All set-asides and tie-bid preferences (Table 2) accounted for \$208 million in awards. The following table shows the dollar and percent distribution of awards in LSA's by type of preference.

A comparison of the above data to fiscal year 1978 shows that the total preference awards were \$155 million or 0.6 percent of the \$26,123 million total Labor Surplus Area awards. In fiscal year 1979 the total of set-asides and tie-bid preference awards were \$123 million or 0.6 percent of total LSA awards. This compares to \$82 million or 0.3 percent in fiscal year 1978. When comparing the percentage of various types of preference to the total preference awards, we find a difference in the percentage of set-asides and tie-bid preference awards to total preference of 6 percent from fiscal year 1978 to 1979. The combined small business/LSA set-asides increased from 23 to 41 percent over the fiscal years.
