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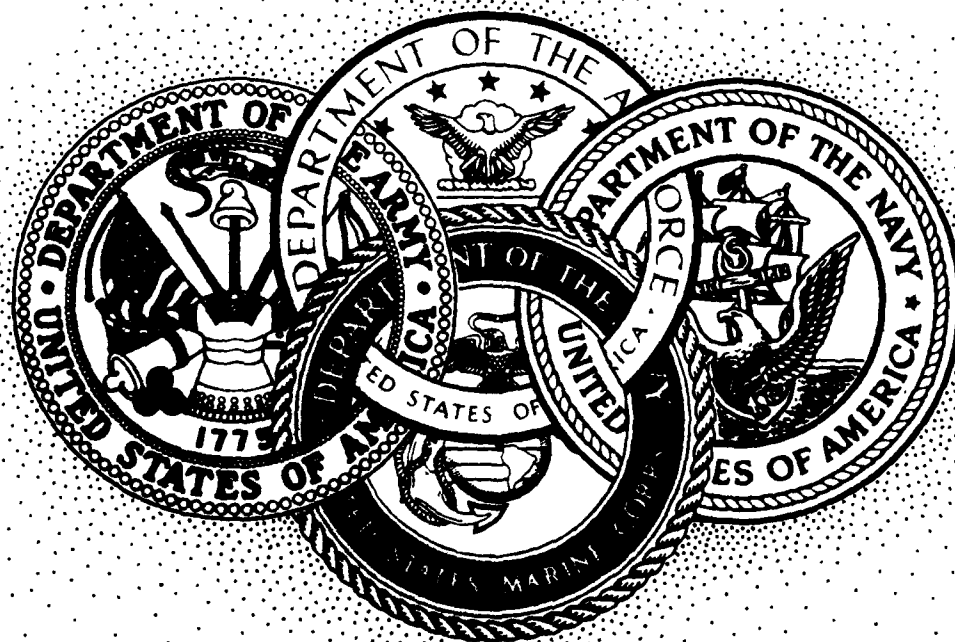
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PREFACE

To assist student researchers in a better understanding of how the United States armed services work together, the US Army War College Library presents this revised and updated edition of JOINTNESS: A SELECTED BIBLIOGRAPHY.
