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The Atlanta University Center, Inc. and the Southern Center for Electrical Engineering Education, co-hosted an Opportunities in Air Force Research and Development Workshop, under the sponsorship of the Air Force Office of Scientific Research, held in Atlanta, Georgia December 4, 1979.

As sub-contractor, the Atlanta University Center, Inc. compiled a list of invitees from 102 historically Black colleges and universities in the southeast region; prepared and sent invitations; secured required facilities; reserved lodging and handled all necessary arrangements which insured successful implementation of the workshop activities.

The workshop attracted 127 participants, representing 69 Black colleges and universities. As a result of these efforts, scientists from 13 institutions participated in summer research programs with one of the national Air Force Labs.

The workshop was considered successful, not only as indicated by the research awards received by many of the participants, but by the fact that through this effort, minority scientists were provided with information on various Air Force research and professional programs. In turn, the Air Force was exposed to another scientific segment capable of addressing their research needs.

The Atlanta University Center, Inc., in order to present its plan as an initiator to encourage participation in the U.S. Air Force Office of Research and Development programs, proposed three workshops to be conducted on a regional basis, convening 300-400 minority scientists from 19 states and 77 colleges and universities. This would be a series of three, one day workshops designed to provide information regarding the basic purposes and research concerns of the U.S. Air Force; the role of Black institutions, corresponding to these concerns, along with providing information on professional programs available through the Air Force Laboratories.

The Atlanta University Center, Inc., working with designated contact persons from host institutions, organized three regional workshops:

- (1) North Carolina A & T State University, May 4-5, 1981
- (2) Tennessee State University, May 7-8, 1981
- (3) Texas Southern University, May 11-12, 1981

Figures as a result of the three workshops totaled 115 participants, representing 47 institutions from 15 states. The statistical summary represents approximately 50% of the projected participation by institution and state. Although the sessions were considered worthwhile and informative by those who participated, there were several planning aspects that affected their outcome. Originally, the workshops were scheduled during January, 1981. Through discussions with AFSOR the schedule was changed to May, 1981. From the outset, the Center expressed concern regarding the availability of professors during a time when a majority of institutions were involved with final examinations. Center staff surveyed a random sample of invitees to determine the level of participation. Based on this inquiry, it was agreed upon by staff and AFSOR to proceed with the workshops.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Future workshops should be planned in two year intervals, maintaining the regional approach to the presentation of AFOSR programs, as opposed to one large group session. Annual presentations would increase the probability of interacting with many of the same institutional representatives. Presentations every two years, on a regional basis, would be less costly and could attract scientists not having and previous exposure to AFOSR programs. Future workshops should be scheduled during the months of October or November. This schedule would allow interested researchers the time to submit application materials for laboratory research awards and would not conflict with a majority of the institutional academic schedules. It is also recommended that the workshops be held at or close to a minority engineering school, based on the tendency of AFOSR programs to lean towards the engineering field. Finally, the number of presentations should be reduced, considering the fact that many tend to overlap in information. Fewer presentations, representing a wider area of concern would allow more time for one to one interaction between participants and AFOSR personnel.
