

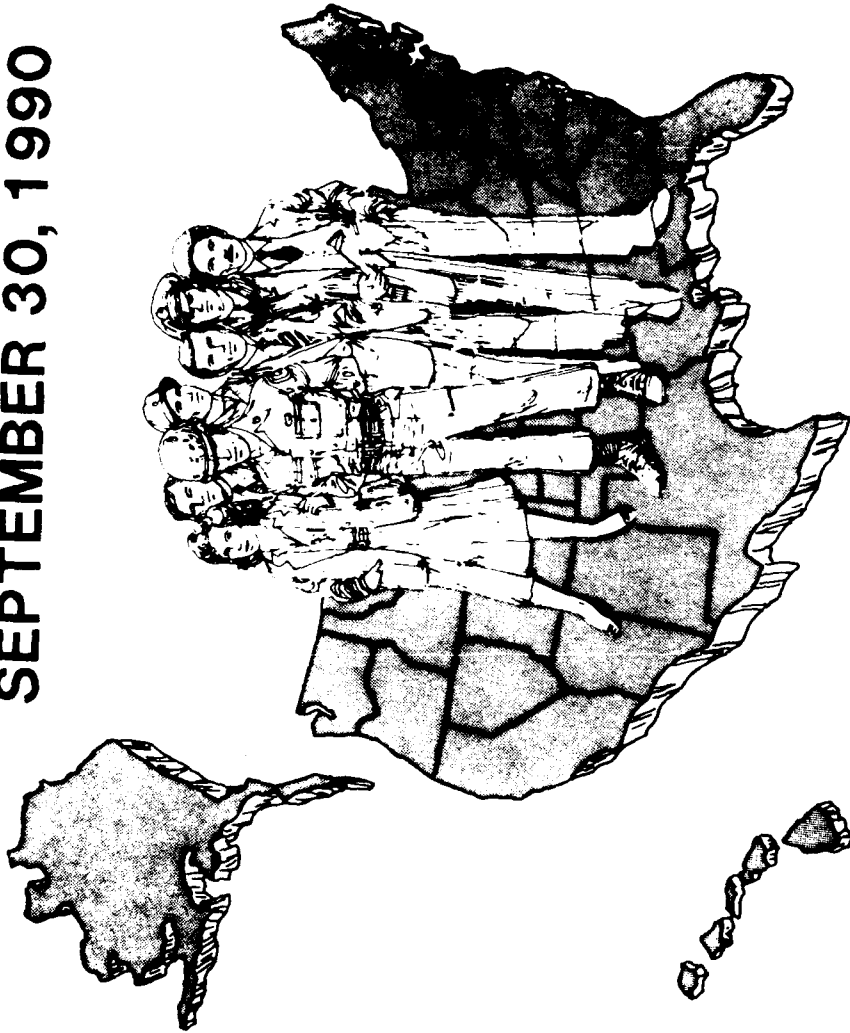

## FOREWORD

*Distribution of Personnel by State and by Selected Locations* is published annually by the Office of the Secretary of Defense, Washington Headquarters Services, Directorate for Information Operations and Reports (WHS/DIOR).

This report provides information on Department of Defense (DoD) personnel by operating location as of September 30, 1990. This information is provided in two sections showing:

1. The percent distribution of DoD active duty military and direct hire civilian personnel, by state, according to Defense component; and
2. DoD active duty military and direct hire civilian personnel, by installation or selected city, according to Defense component.

## INTRODUCTION

This publication is prepared from information submitted annually to Washington Headquarters Services, Directorate for Information Operations and Reports (WHS/DIOR) under Reports Control Symbol DD-COMP(A) 659. Information is reported to WHS/DIOR by the Military Departments and Defense Agencies. These data provide statistics on the number of active duty military and direct hire civilian personnel by operating location in the United States, with operating location defined as the geographic location where personnel are located for the performance of work.

This report is divided into two sections. In each, the information is presented according to Defense component, including the Military Departments (Army, Navy, and Air Force) and the category "Other DoD Organizations." This latter classification includes the following:

In Section One, the total number of active duty military and direct hire civilian personnel as of September 30, 1990, are presented by state according to Defense component. Included is information on the percentage of each component's personnel located in each state. In Section Two, the active duty military and direct hire civilian personnel are shown for selected cities and installations in each state according to Defense component.

Special attention is directed to the following:

1. In some instances, the Military Departments report personnel by parent installation rather than their operating location. Such variations tend to occur in metropolitan areas where military activities are scattered among many political jurisdictions. In addition, personnel on temporary duty (TDY) on September 30, 1990, may be reported at their assigned locations.
2. Military personnel in each department include a number of personnel in a transient status. These personnel are in a travel, proceed, leave en route, or temporary duty status while on permanent change of station (PCS) orders. The Marine Corps and Air Force report these personnel at their location prior to their new permanent duty location. The Army and Navy include these personnel in one category entitled "Undistributed", which may also include personnel for which an exact location is undetermined.
3. Excluded from the direct hire civilian personnel in this publication are those who are not subject to Office of Management and Budget (OMB) ceiling controls. This includes personnel such as summer aids or employees in the Stay-in-School Federal Junior Fellowship, and Worker-Trainee Opportunity Programs and those covered by other official exemptions granted by OMB. As of September 30, 1990, the Department of Defense employed 9,697 nonceiling civilian employees.
4. Department of the Army direct hire civilian personnel subject to OMB ceilings include employees involved in civil functions in the United States. This consisted of 27,133 employees of the Army Corps of Engineers and 124 Army cemetery employees. Also included in this report is one civil function personnel of the Air Force.
5. Department of the Navy military personnel include those in the military services of the Navy and Marine Corps. The Navy Department military totals consist of shore-based personnel and exclude those personnel who are afloat (243,151) and temporary shore-based (58,448).
6. Reserve/National Guard personnel called to active duty under 10 USC 673(b) are not included in the active duty military personnel counts except for 2,439 enlisted personnel of the Navy.
