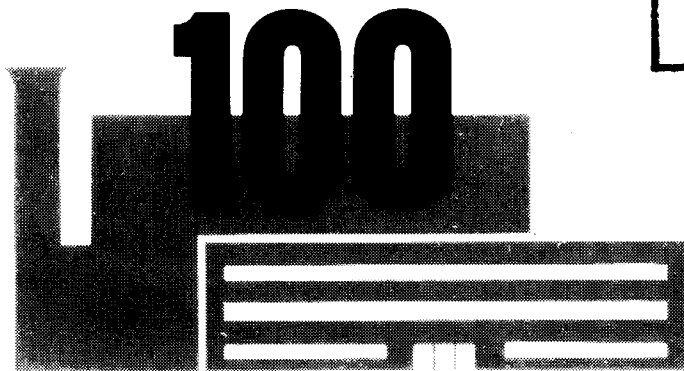

INTRODUCTION

This report presents summary data on the 100 companies, and their subsidiaries, receiving the largest dollar volume of Department of Defense (DoD) prime contract awards during fiscal year (FY) 1994. Table 1, page 7, lists the 100 companies in alphabetical order and gives their associated rank. Table 2, page 9, identifies the parent companies in rank order, with their subsidiaries, and gives the total net value of awards for both the parent company and its subsidiaries. In many cases, the parent company receives no awards itself, but appears on the list because of its subsidiaries. Table 2 also shows what percentage of the total awards each company's awards represent, as well as the cumulative percentage represented by all companies.

NOTES ON COVERAGE

Data in this report reflect the net value of both debit and credit procurement actions over \$25,000; e.g., the value of a terminated contract, or other downward adjustment to a contract, is deducted from a firm's total award amount, while modifications and other positive adjustments are treated as increases. Procurement actions include definitive contracts, the obligated portions of letter contracts, job orders, task orders, delivery orders, and any other orders against existing contracts. Research and development, services, construction, and supply and equipment contracts, worldwide, are included.

The report does not include those parts of indefinite quantity contracts that have not been translated into specific orders to business firms or those contracts that have not yet become mutually binding agreements between the government and the company. The company totals do not include contracts made by other U.S. Government Agencies and financed with Department of Defense funds or contracts awarded in foreign nations through their respective governments.

DATA RELATING TO COMPANIES IN THIS PUBLICATION ARE SUBJECT TO THE ACCURACY OF THE FEDERAL PROCUREMENT DATA SYSTEM CONTRACTOR ESTABLISHMENT CODE, AND THE ABILITY OF THIS CODING SYSTEM TO DESCRIBE RELATIONSHIPS OF COMPANIES.

HIGHLIGHTS

DoD prime contract awards over \$25,000 totaled \$118.1 billion during FY 1994, \$5.6 billion less than in FY 1993. The 100 firms, and their subsidiaries, receiving the largest amount of DoD contracts in FY 1994 received \$73.1 billion, or 61.9 percent of all awards, primarily for aircraft, missile/space systems, ships, and electronics & communications equipment. In FY 1993, the top 100 companies received \$76.1 billion, or 61.5 percent of all awards.

Exhibit A below shows that the first five companies received 23 percent of the total received by all companies in FY 1994, compared with 21.4 percent during FY 1993. The company ranked as number one during FY 1994, McDonnell Douglas Corp., also ranked as number one in FY 1993, with awards of \$9.3 billion during FY 1994, compared with \$7.5 billion during FY 1993. The smallest total amount received by a company in the FY 1994 Table 2 was \$113.2 million, compared to \$113.9 million in FY 1993.

Changes in the Top 100 Companies, FY 1993 To FY 1994

Twenty-three companies which did not appear on the list in FY 1993 are among the top 100 companies in FY 1994, see Exhibit B on page 3. Of these, one appears in position 52, one in position 53, and the balance between 58 and 100. The companies which appeared on the FY 1993 list but did not appear on the FY 1994 list are also shown in Exhibit B. Companies are considered as appearing on the list in both fiscal years despite mergers, acquisitions, divestitures, and name changes if a major component of a newly constituted company, or the newly constituted company itself, made the list as a component of a company in the top 100 in the prior year.

The most significant change during FY 1994 was the acquisition of Grumman Corporation by Northrop Corporation. Fifteen of the 23 companies listed in FY 1994, but not in FY 1993, were included in the top 200 for FY 1993. Also, 14 of the 22 listed in FY 1993, but not in FY 1994, remain in the top 200.

Primary Procurement Categories of the Top 100 Companies

Although the contract work of many companies on the list includes more than one procurement category, in Exhibit C, page 4, each company has been assigned to the procurement category that accounts for its largest dollar volume of DoD awards; for example, General Electric Co. is a multi-industry company, producing electronic and communications equipment as well as industrial and consumer products. For the purposes of this exhibit, it has been assigned to "Aircraft," the procurement category accounting for its largest dollar volume of DoD contract awards.
