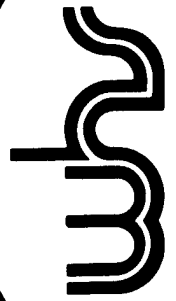

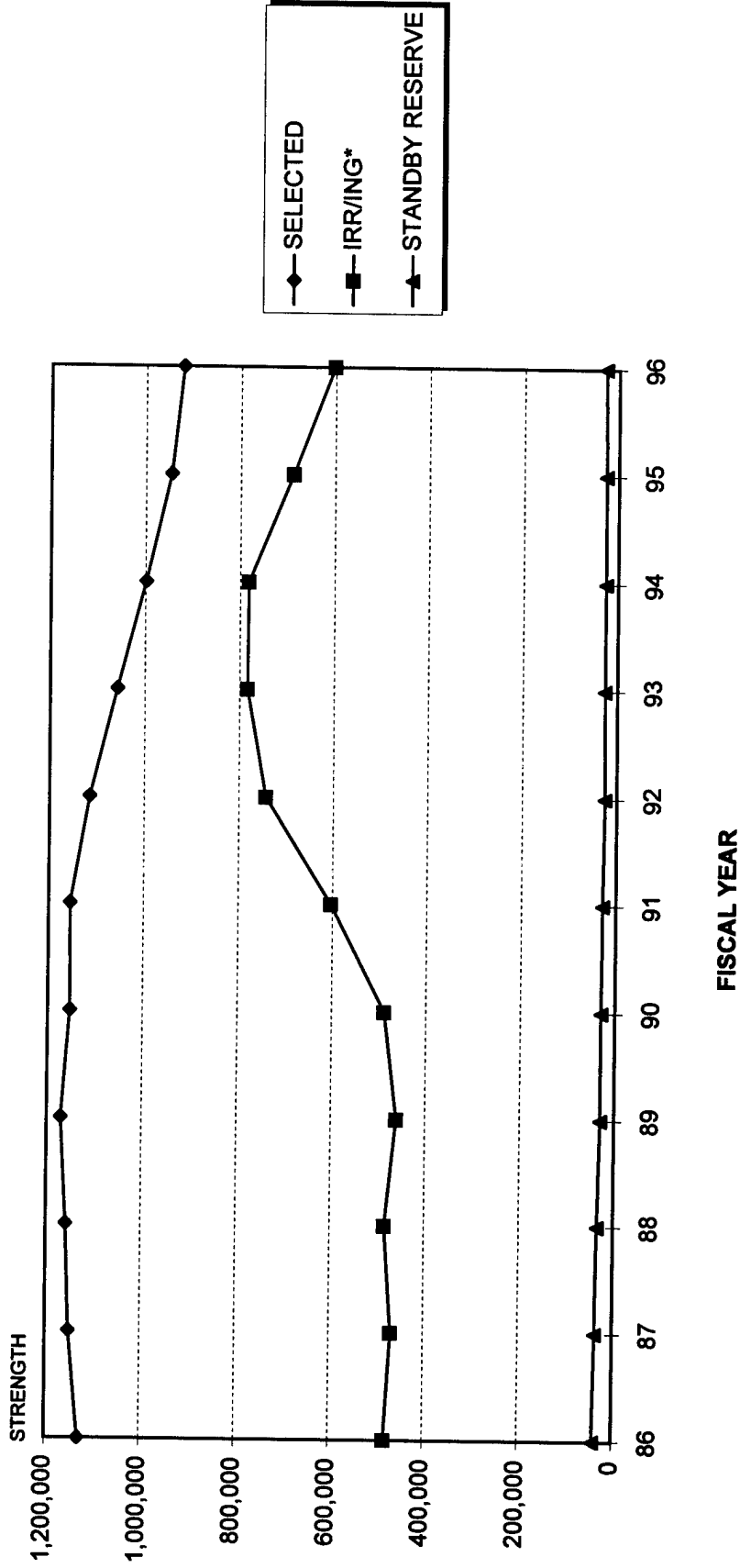

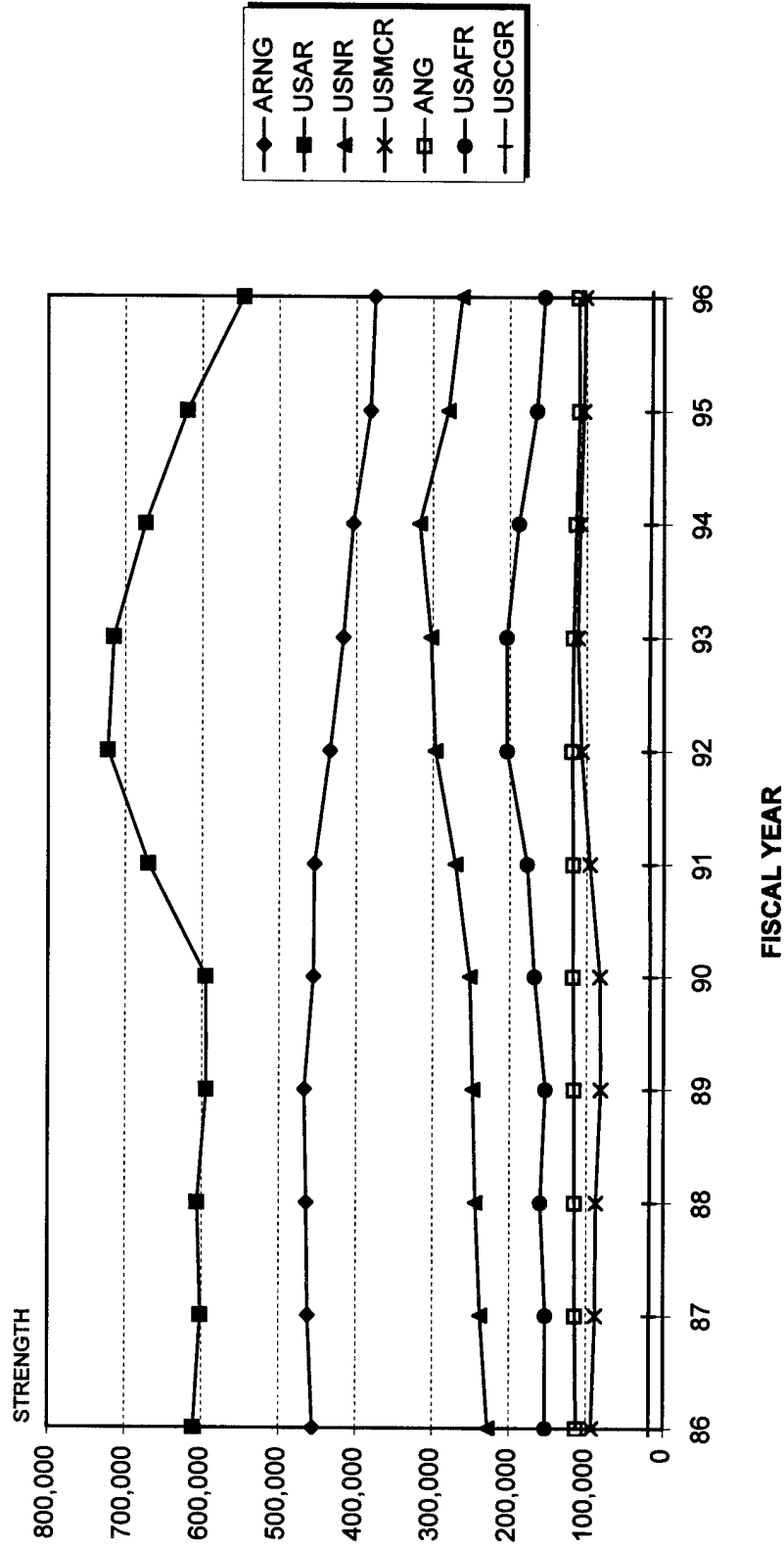

# RESERVE STRENGTH TRENDS BY RESERVE COMPONENT



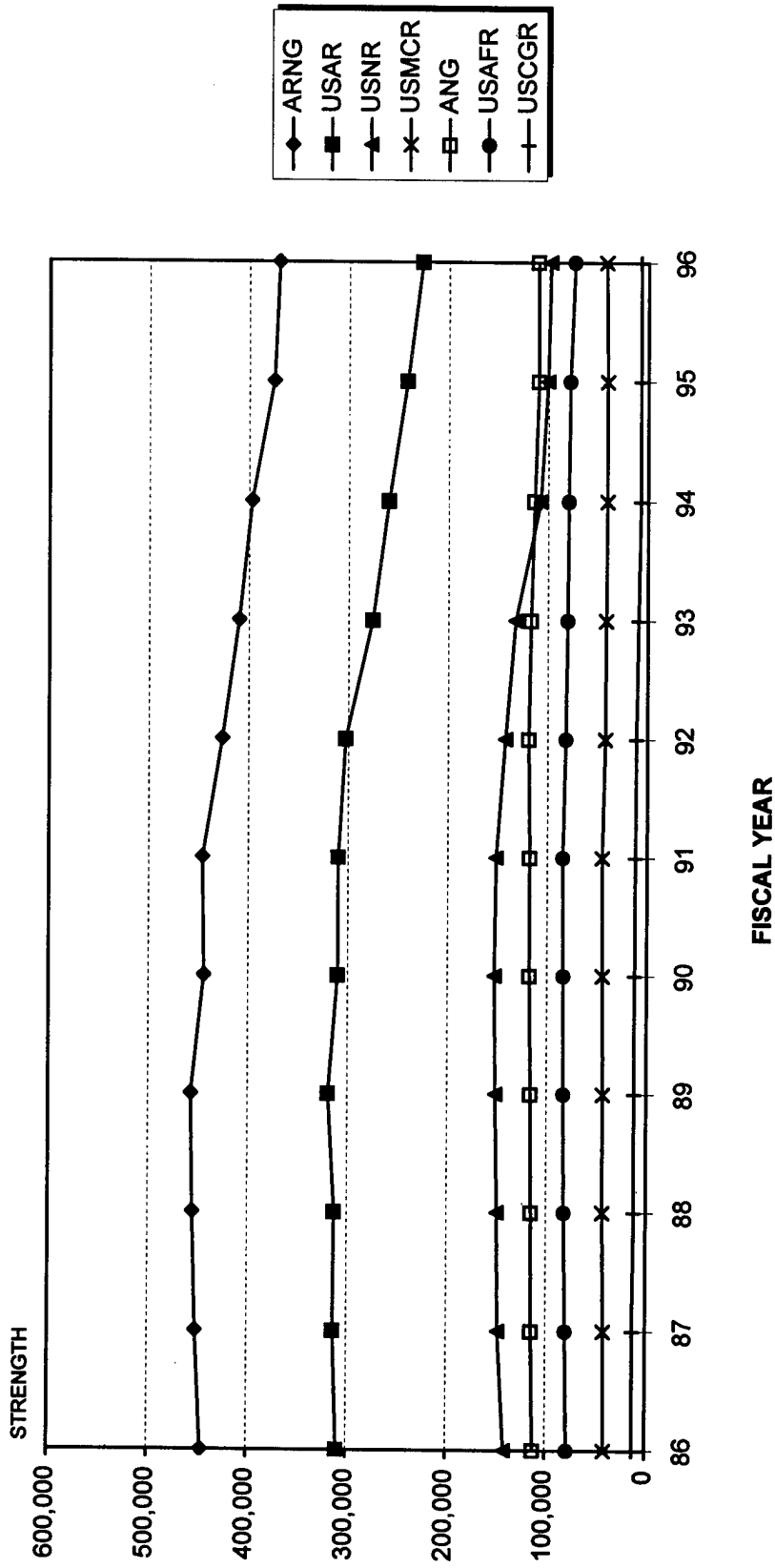

# SELECTED RESERVE STRENGTH TRENDS BY RESERVE COMPONENT



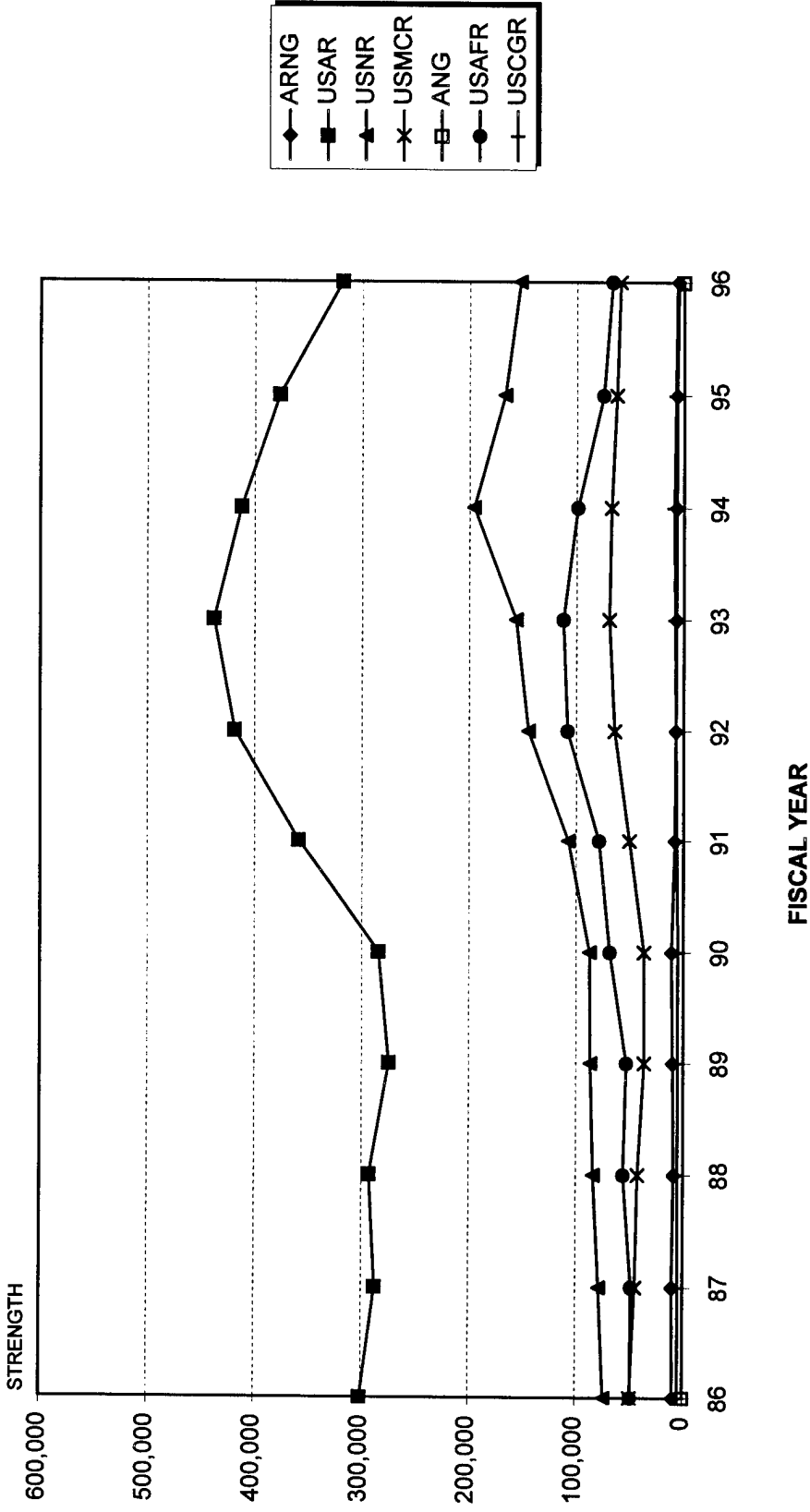

# IRRING STRENGTH TRENDS BY RESERVE COMPONENT



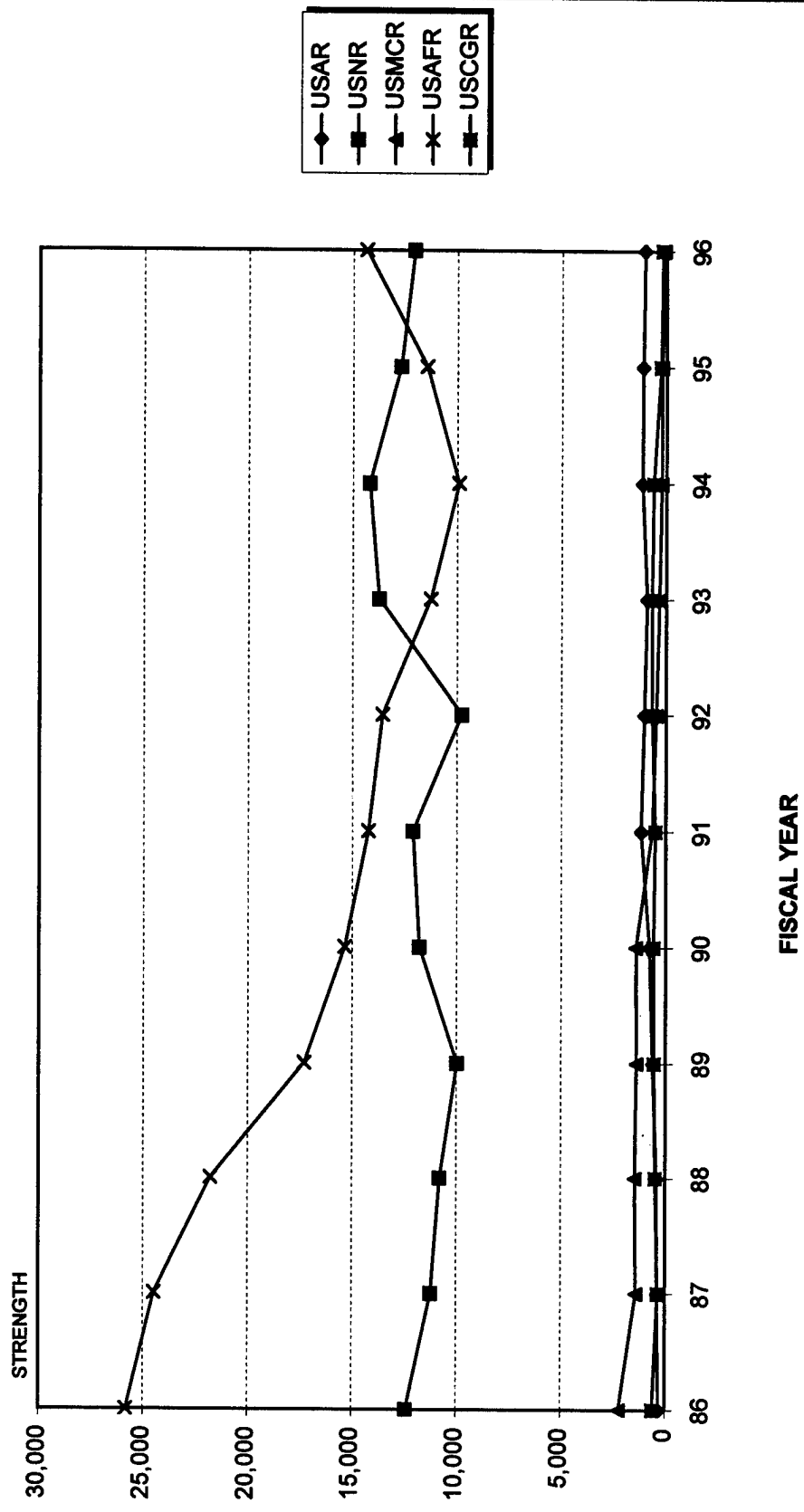

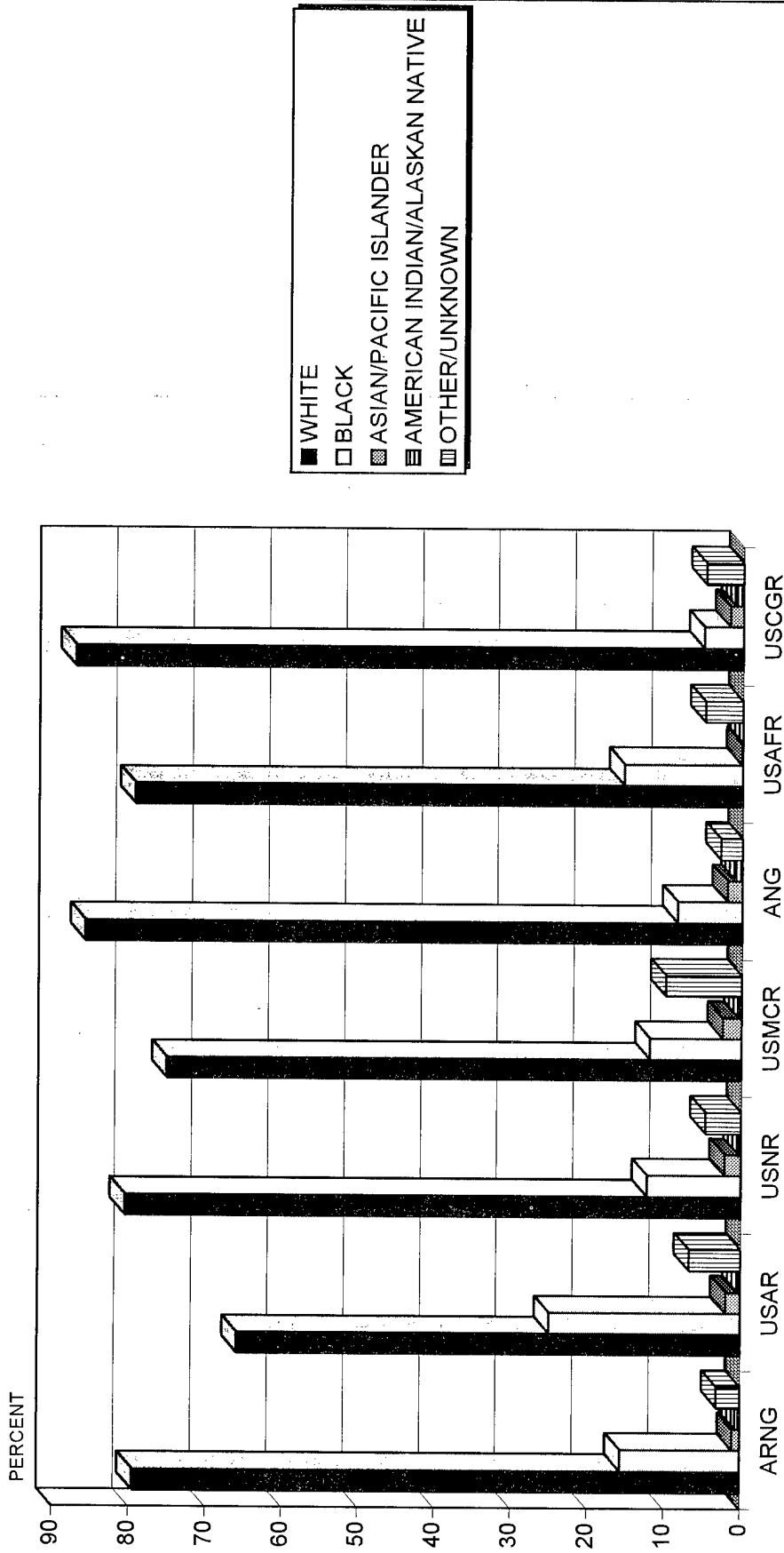

# TOTAL DISTRIBUTION OF THE SELECTED RESERVE BY RACE AND RESERVE COMPONENT



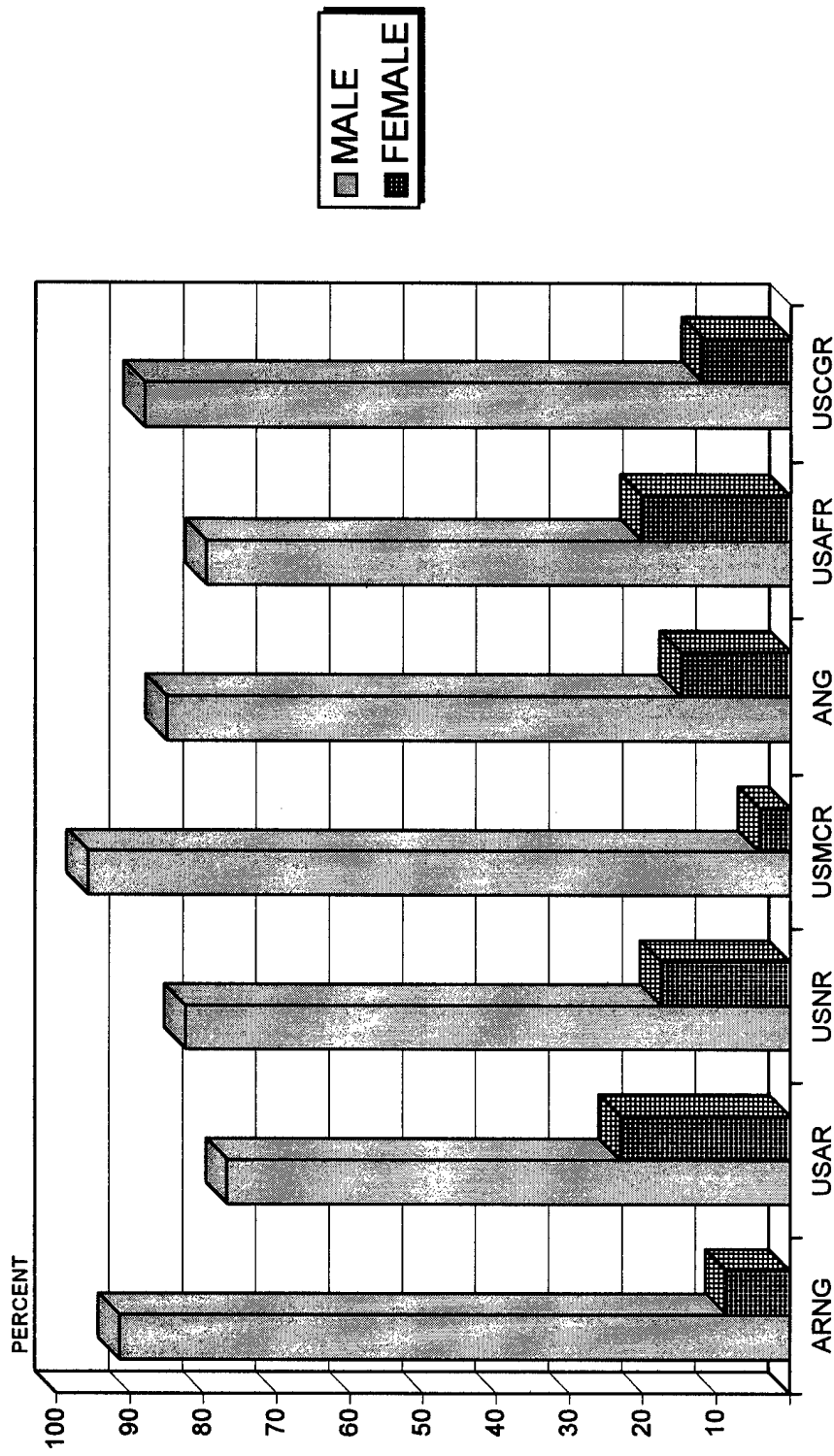

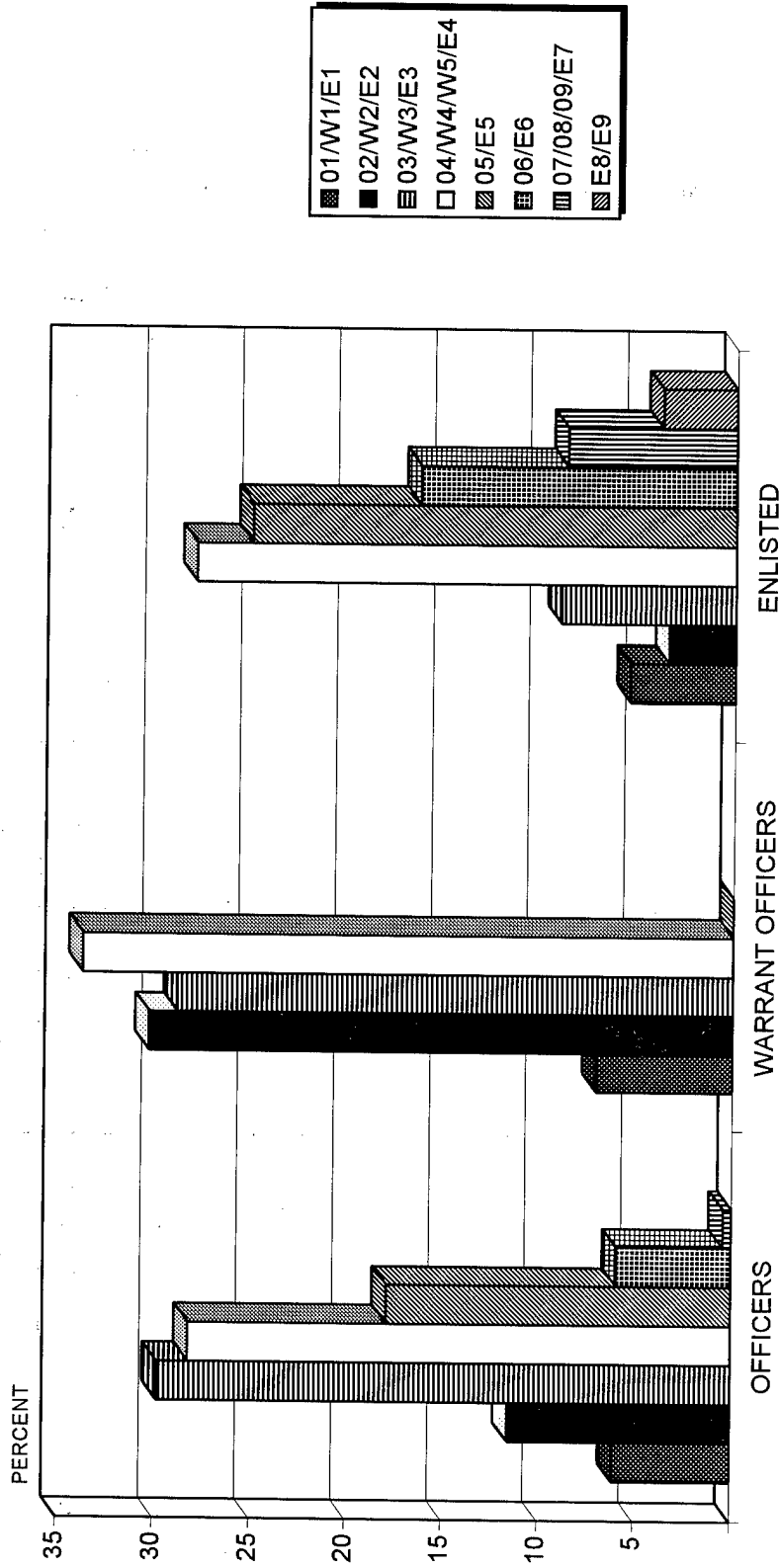

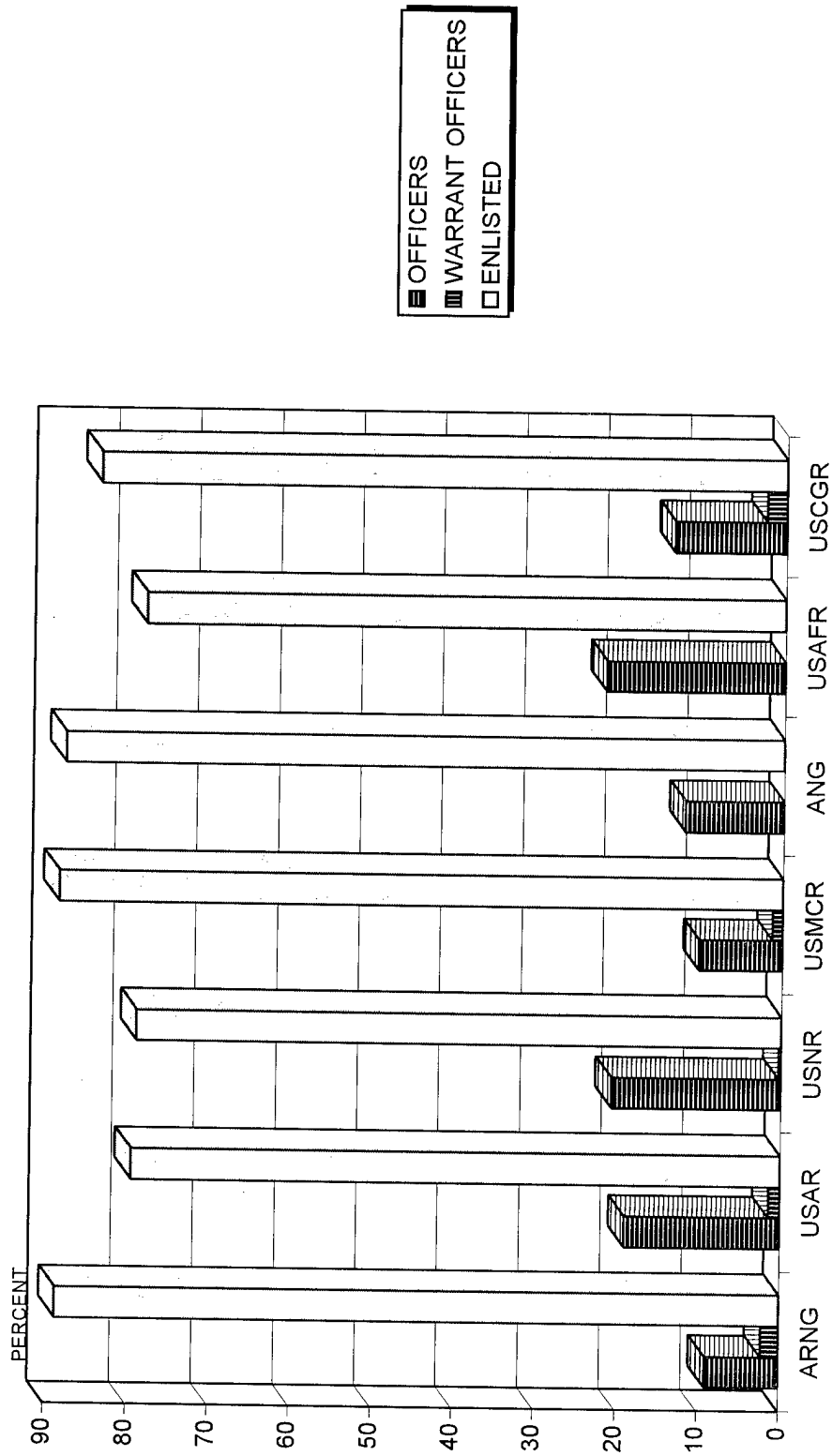

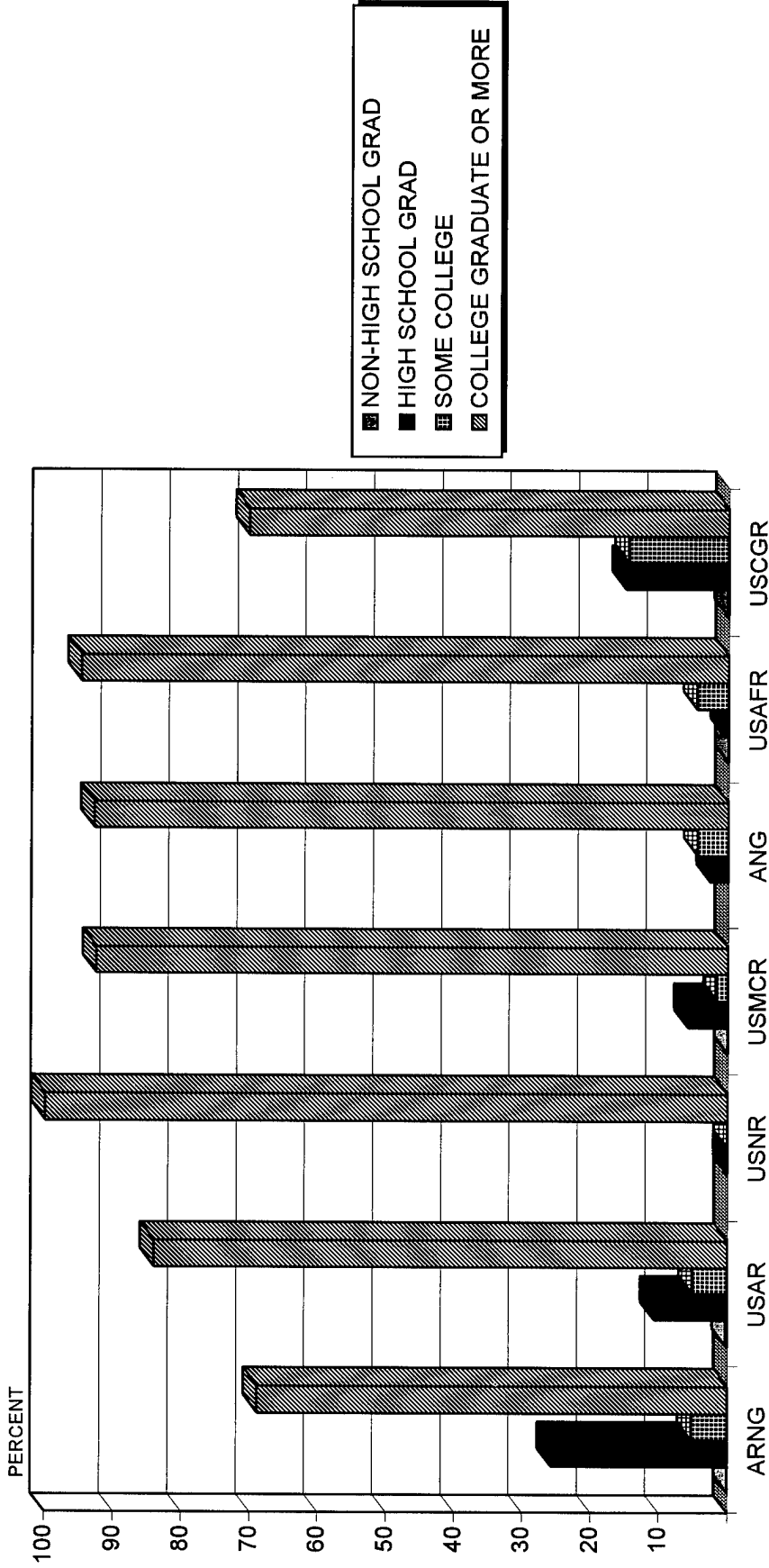

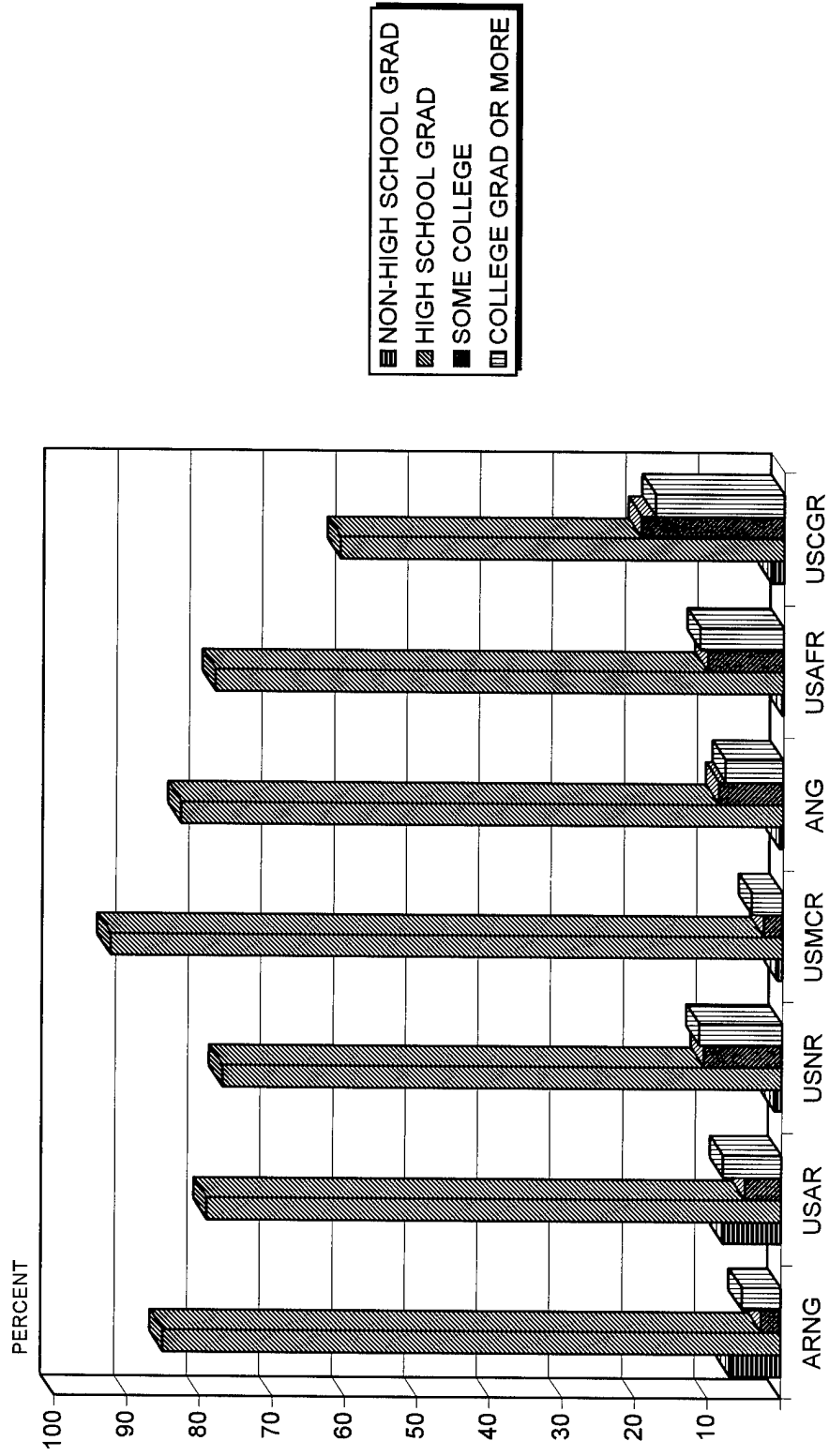

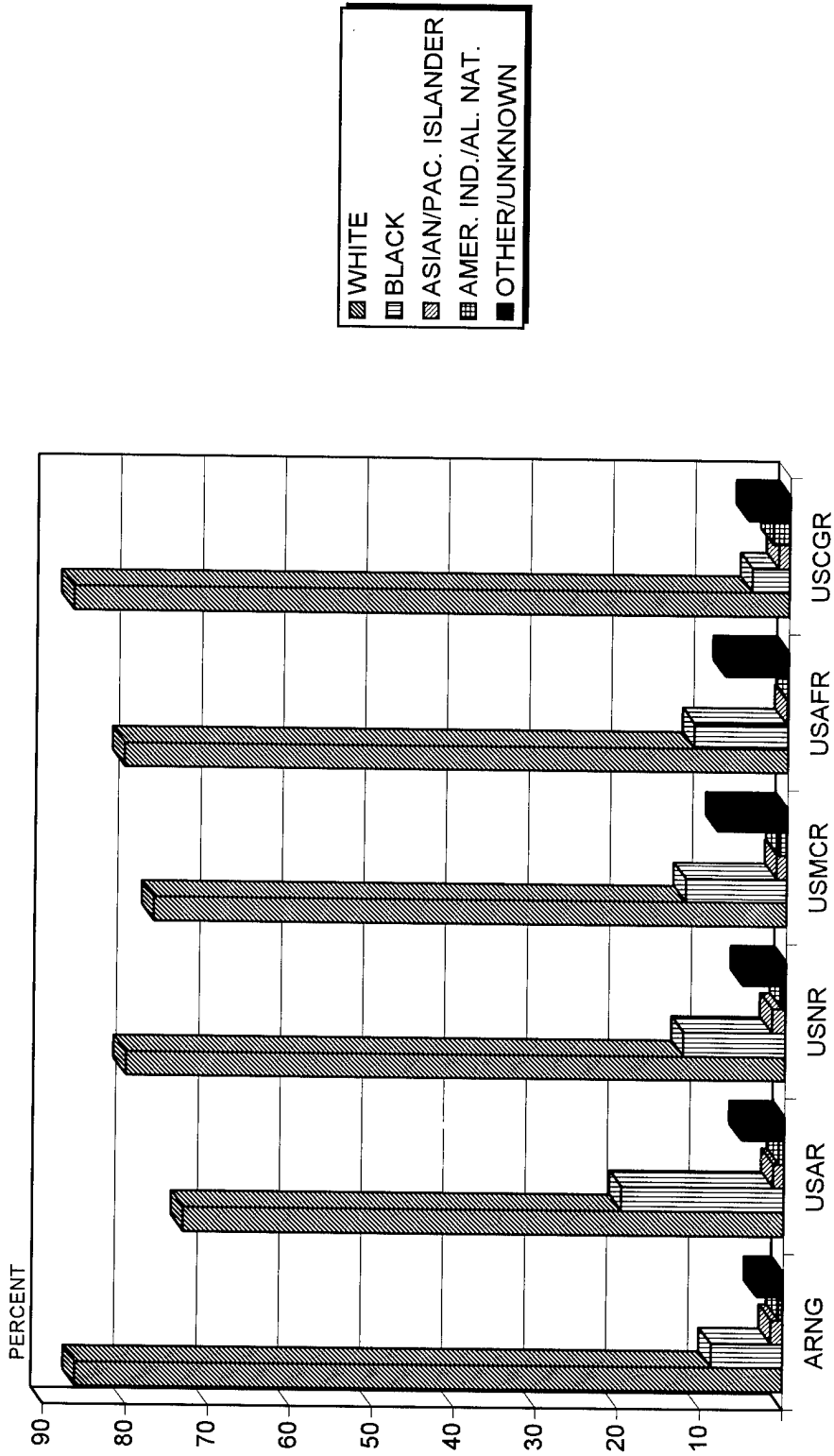

# TOTAL DISTRIBUTION OF THE IRR/ING BY RACE AND RESERVE COMPONENT



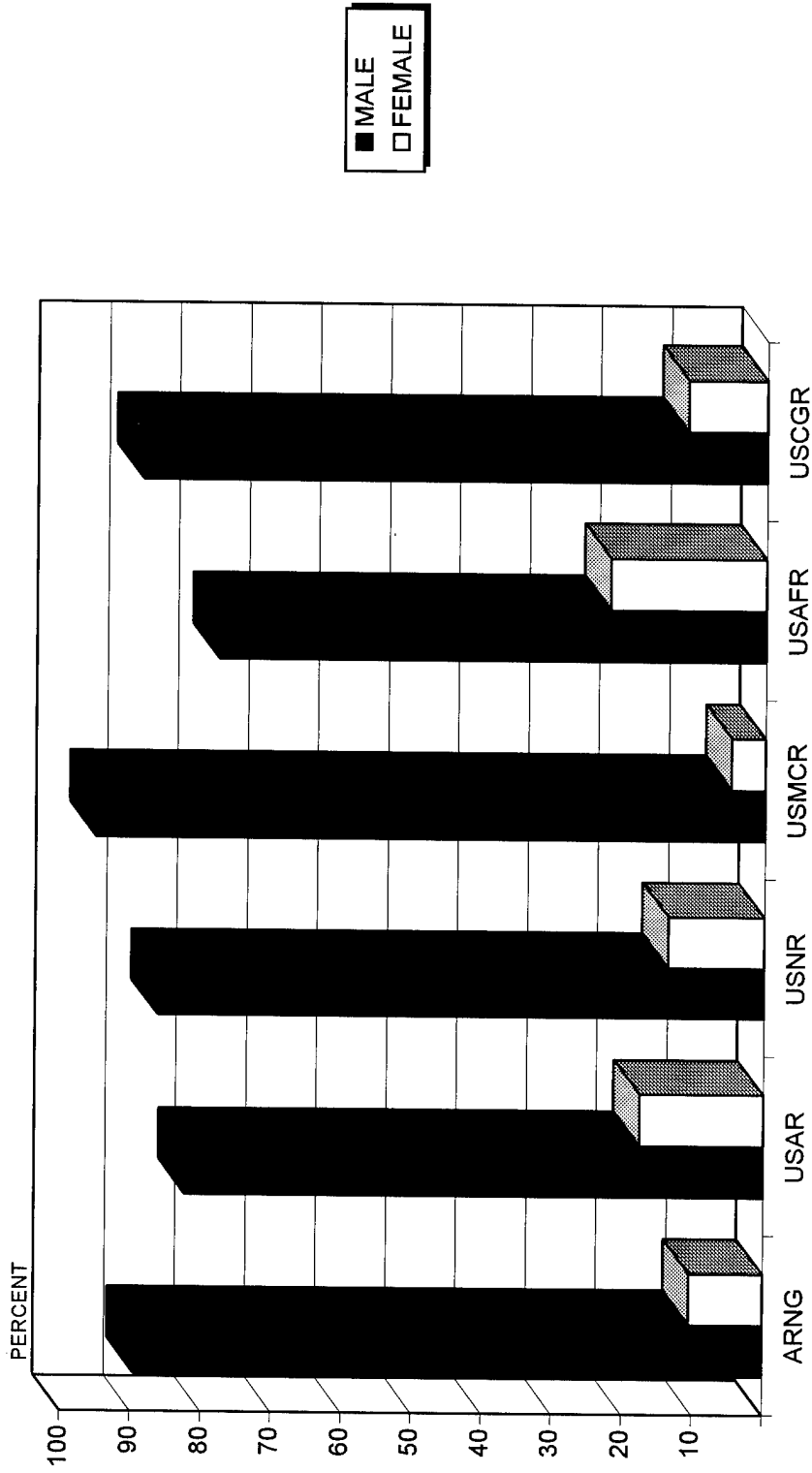

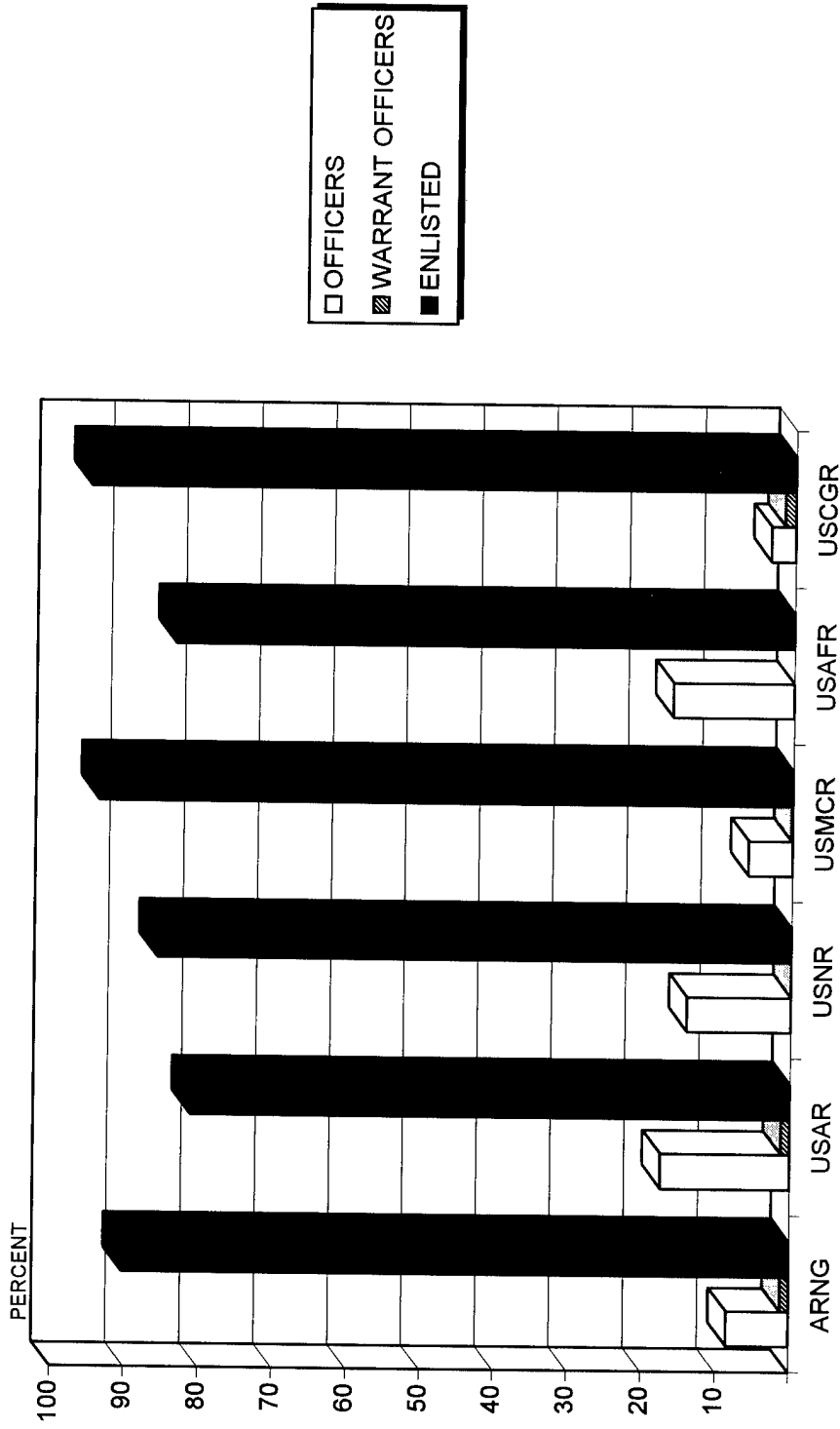

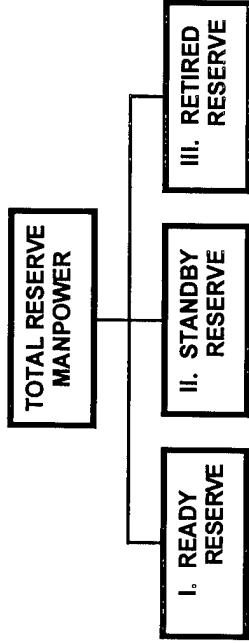
# TOTAL DISTRIBUTION OF THE IRR/ING BY TYPE AND RESERVE COMPONENT



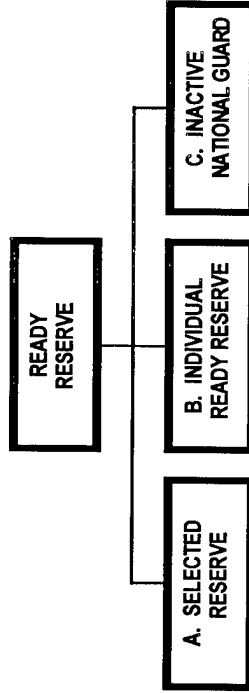

## GLOSSARY OF RESERVE CATEGORY DEFINITIONS

There are three reserve categories: the Ready Reserve, the Standby Reserve, and the Retired Reserve. Each member of the National Guard and Reserve Components is assigned within one of these categories.



I. **Ready Reserve.** The Ready Reserve is comprised of members, organized in units or as individuals, both of which are liable for recall to active duty to augment the active forces in time of war or national emergency as provided by law (Title 10, U.S.C.) and in regulation. The Ready Reserve consists of the Selected Reserve, the Individual Ready Reserve, and the Inactive National Guard.



A. **Selected Reserve.** The Selected Reserve consists of those units and individuals within the Ready Reserve designated by their Services and approved by the Joint Chiefs of Staff as so essential to initial wartime missions that they have priority over all other Reserves. All Selected Reserves are in an active status. Those Ready Reservists who are not in the Selected Reserve are either in the Individual Ready Reserve or the Inactive National Guard.

B. **Individual Ready Reserve (IRR).** The Individual Ready Reserve consists of a manpower pool principally comprised of individuals who have had training and who have served previously in the active forces or in the Selected Reserve and have some period of their military service obligation remaining.

C. **Inactive National Guard (ING).** The Inactive National Guard consists of Army National Guard personnel in an inactive status who are attached to a specific Army National Guard unit, but do not participate in training activities. Upon mobilization, they would mobilize with their units.

II. **Standby Reserve.** The Standby Reserve consists of personnel who (a) wish to maintain their military affiliation without being in the Ready Reserve; (b) who have been designated key civilian employees; or (c) who have a temporary hardship or disability. These individuals are not required to perform training and are not part of units. The Standby Reserve is a pool of trained individuals who could be mobilized if necessary to fill manpower needs in specific skills.

III. **Retired Reserve.** The Retired Reserve is comprised of (a) all Reserve officers who receive retired pay on the basis of their active duty and/or reserve service; (b) all Reserve officers and enlisted members who are otherwise eligible for retired pay but have not reached age 60, and who have not elected discharge and are not voluntary members of the Ready or Standby Reserve; and (c) other retired reservists as further detailed below.

Enlisted Navy and Marine Corps Regular and Reserve members who are retired with 20 or more years of active duty, but less than 30 years, are assigned to the Fleet Reserve (Navy) and Fleet Marine Corps Reserve respectively. When these personnel complete a total of 30 years of active and Fleet Reserve (retired) service, they are then assigned to the Retired Reserve or placed on the regular retired list.

Army and Air Force enlisted personnel (Regular and Reserve) who have completed 20 or more years, but less than 30 years, of active duty are included in the Retired Reserve. When these members complete a total of 30 years of active and retired service, the regular enlisted retirees are placed on the regular retired list.

Retired personnel are a resource of trained individuals who may be used to augment support and training facilities, to relieve Active Component or Ready Reserve members for other duties, or to accomplish operational missions as needed.
