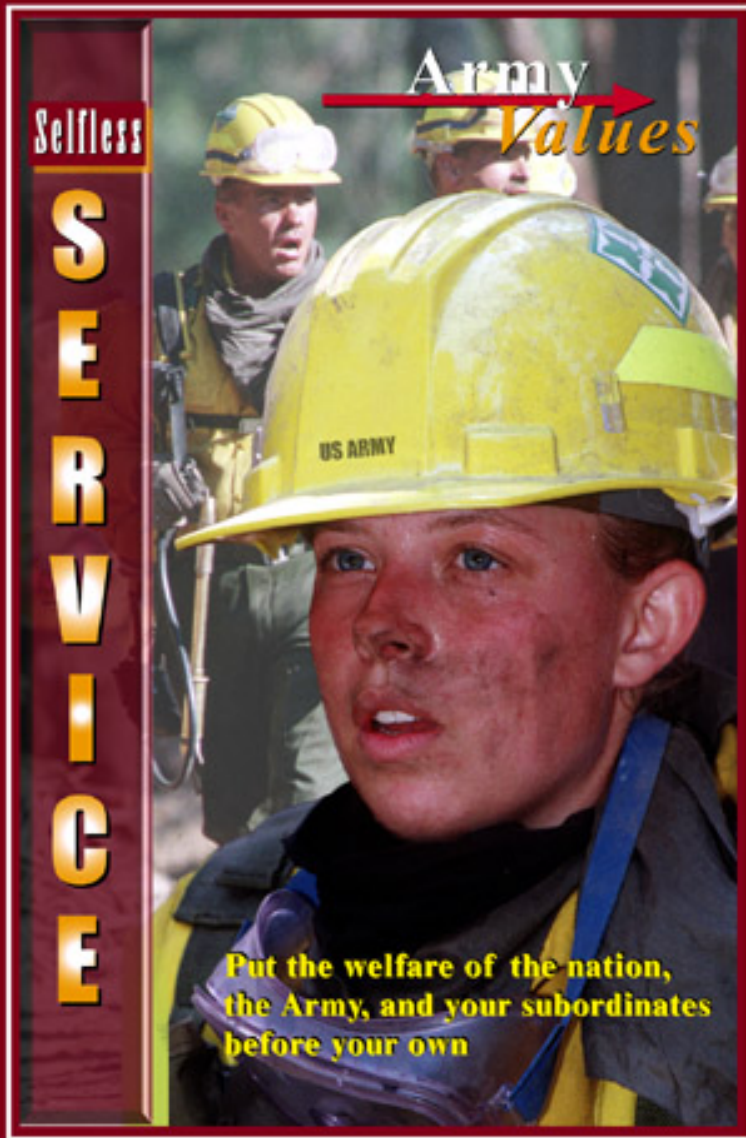

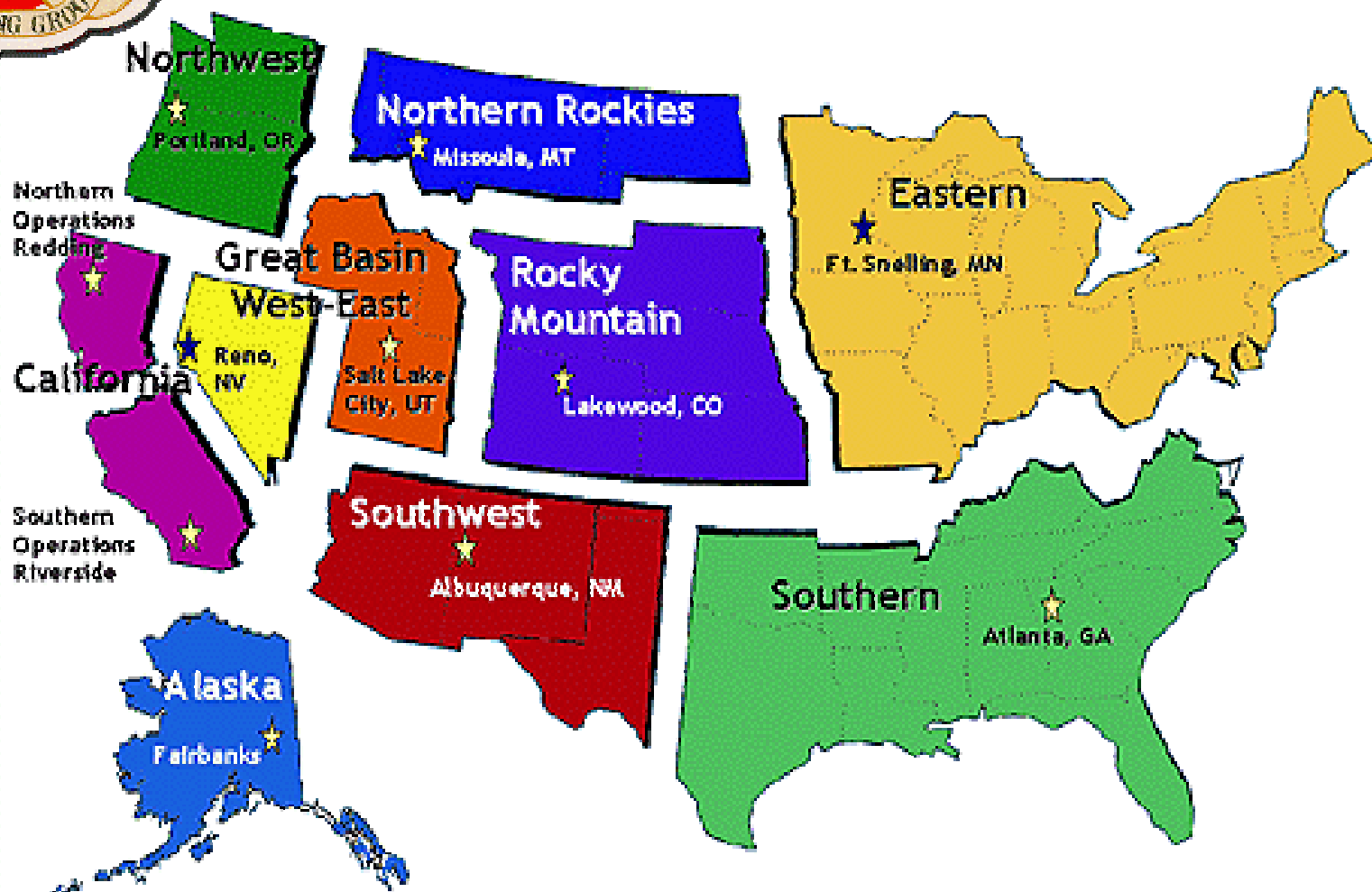

Requesting unit calls GACC.

If GACC cannot fill order, it contacts National Interagency Coordinating Center (NICC). NICC sends request out to the other GACCs

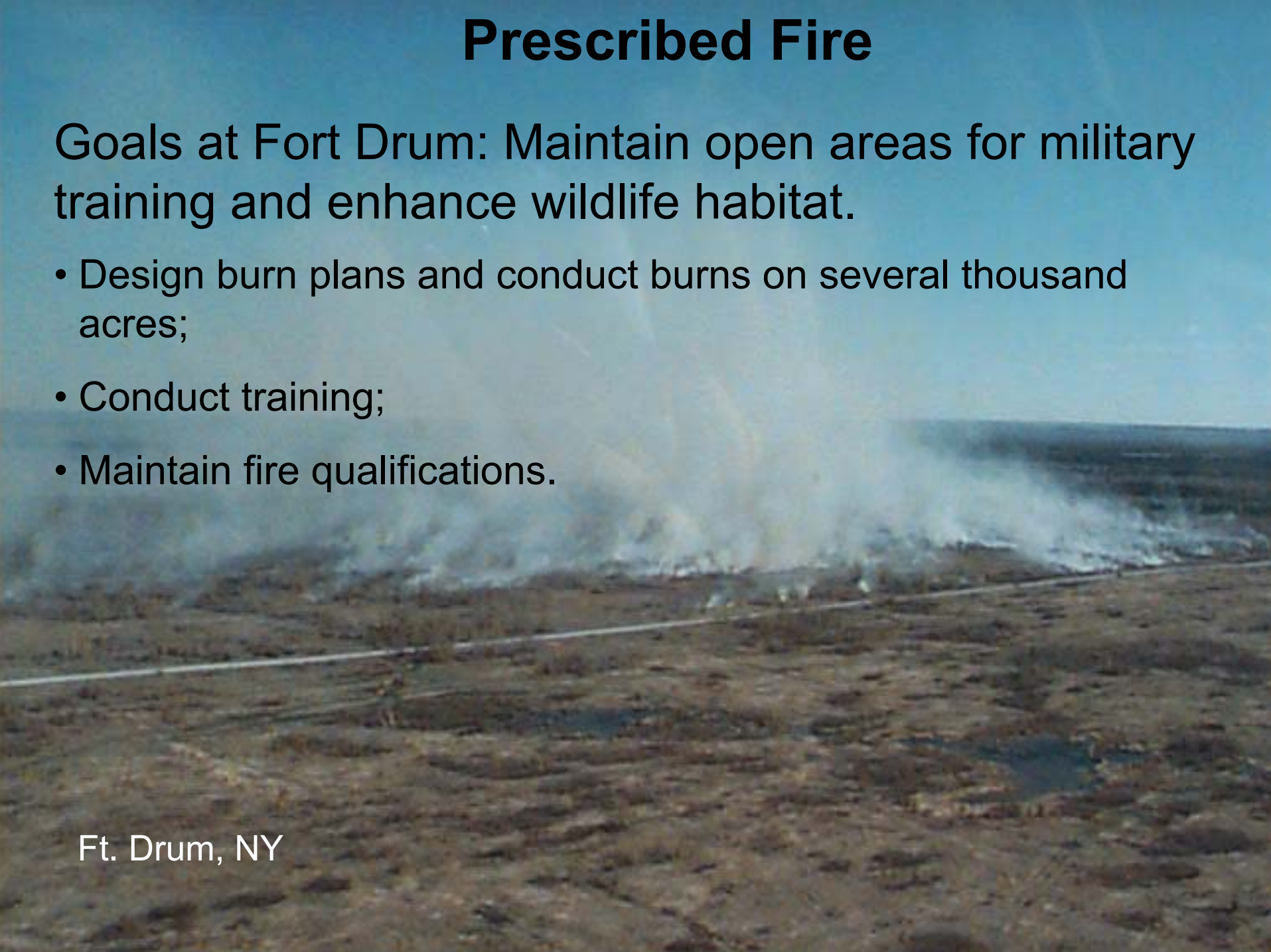


Prescribed Fire
