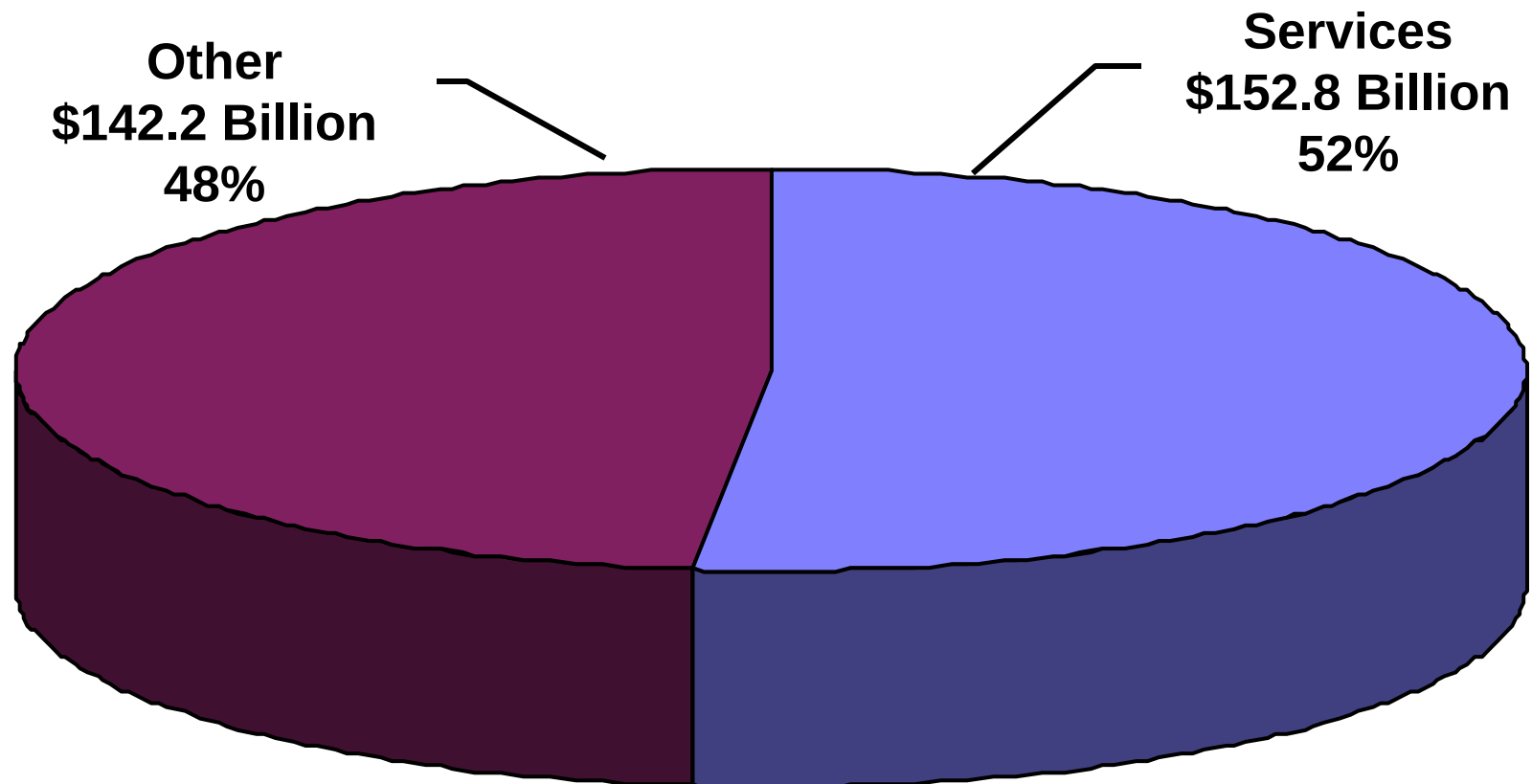
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Why Focus on Services?

FY 2006 DoD Services: \$152.8 Billion

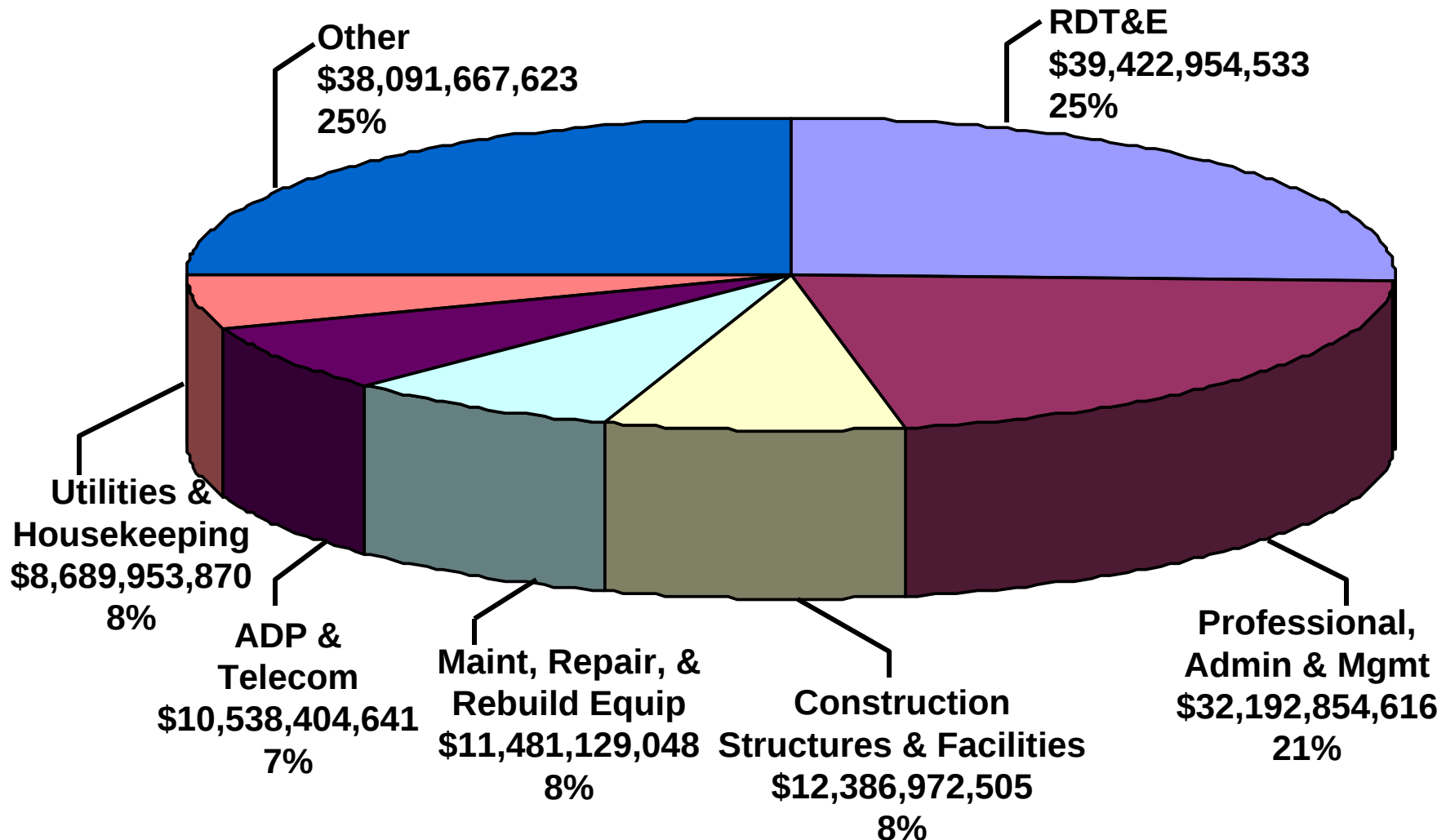




FY 2006 DoD Spending on Services

DoD Services Spend: \$152.8 Billion

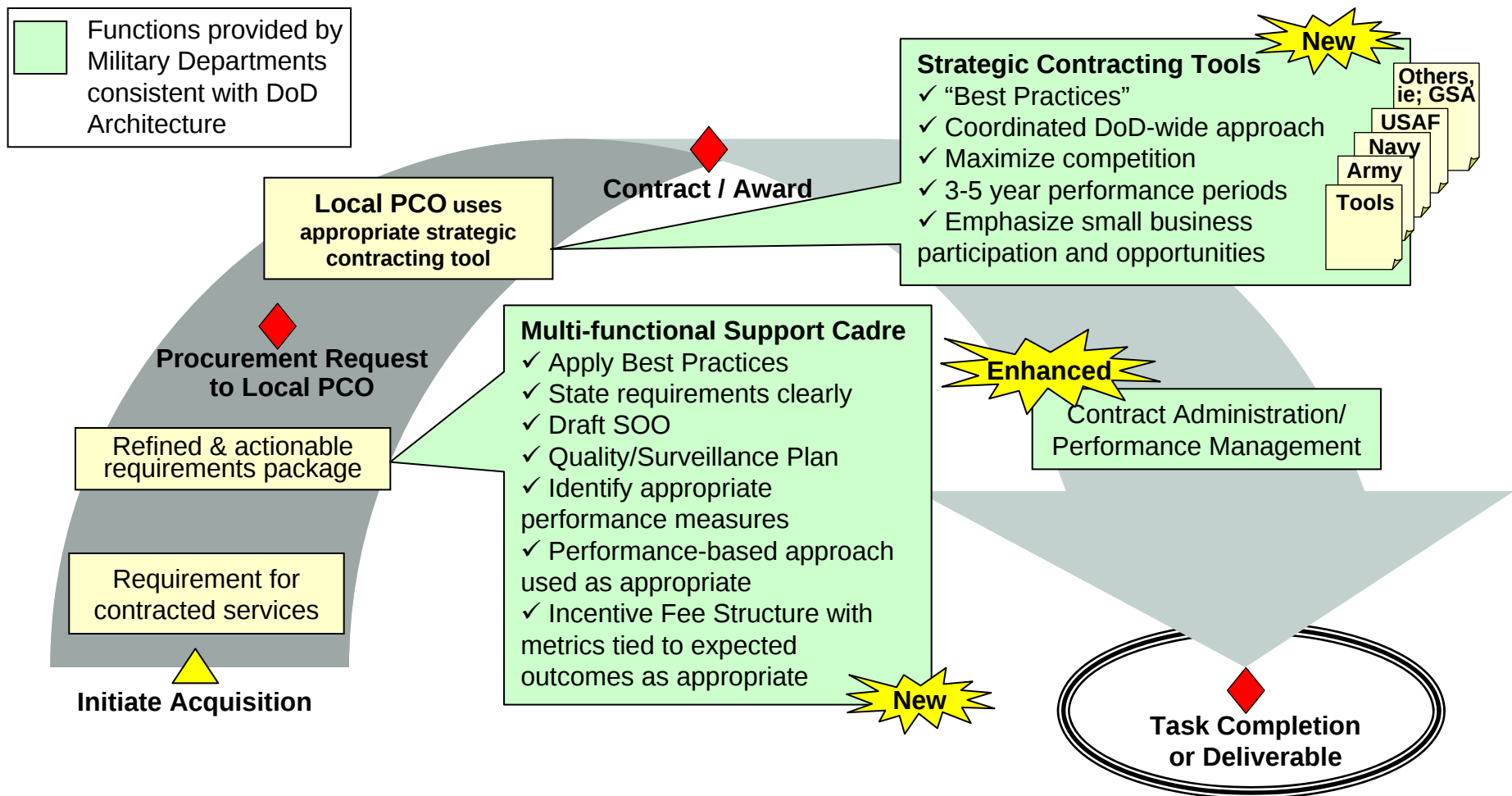




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Management Consistent with FY 06 NDAA Section 812
