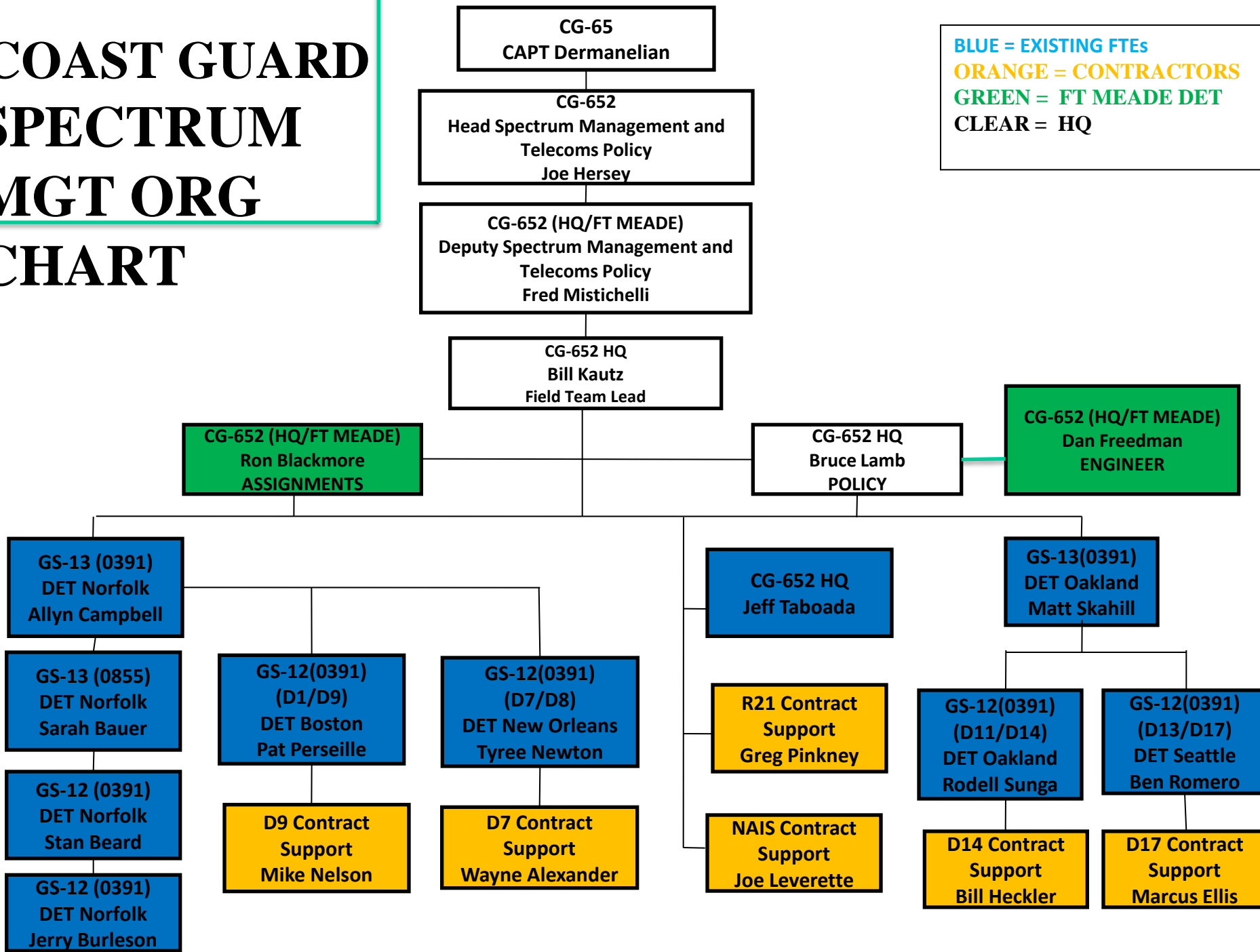
Concerns

- FSMS vs. Spectrum XXI On-Line (Web Based) Operations

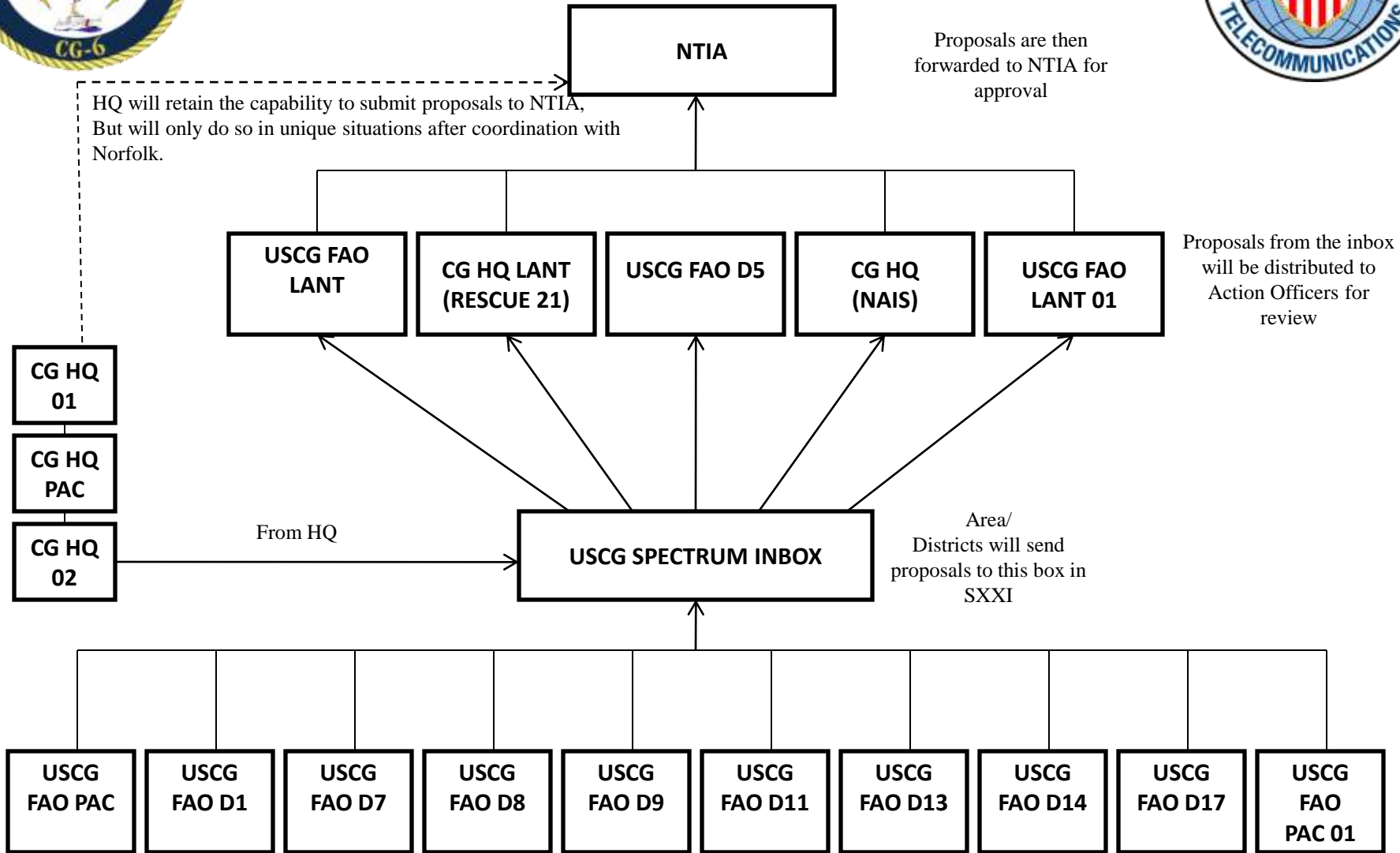
COAST GUARD SPECTRUM MGT ORG CHART

CLEAR = HQ

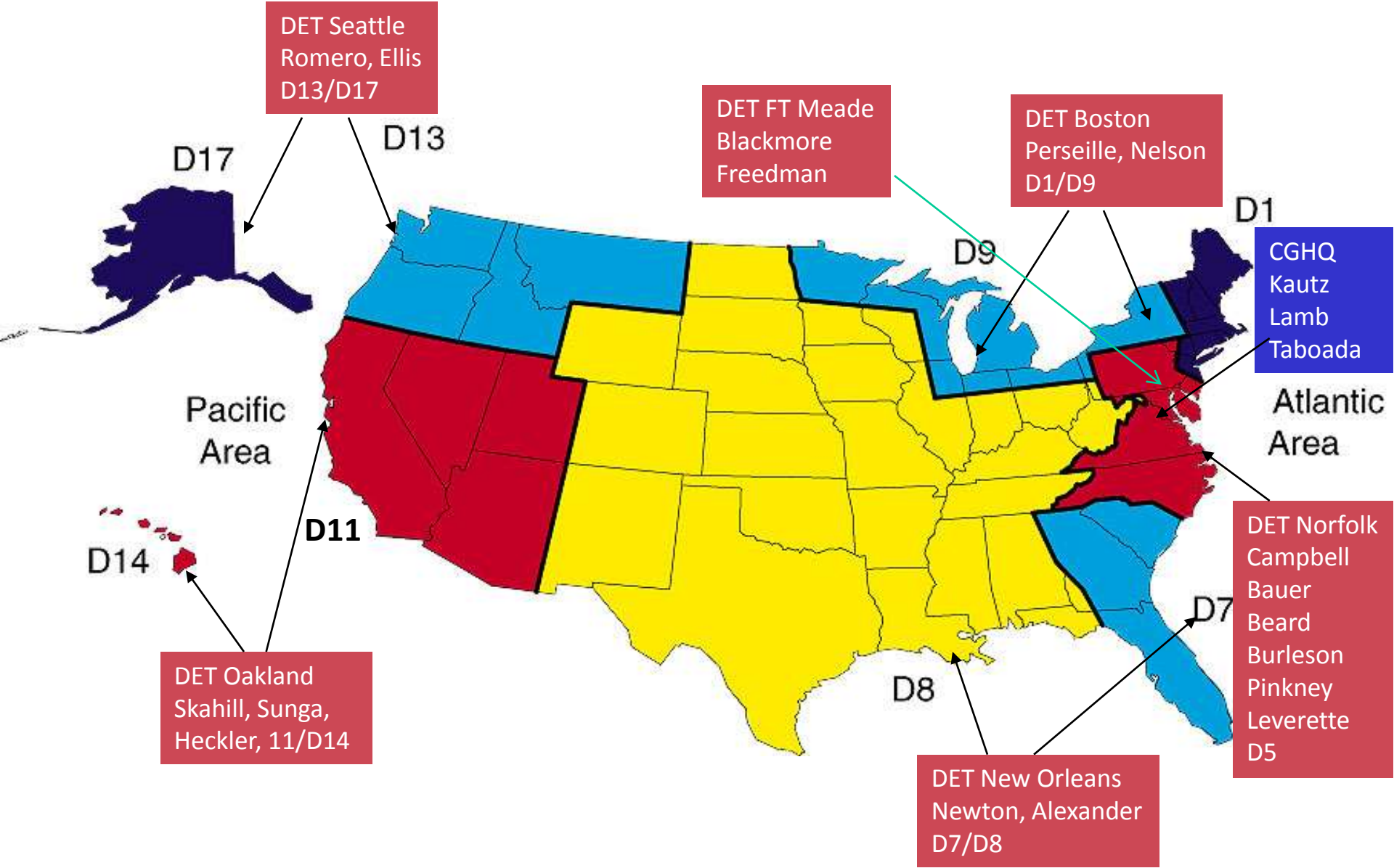




Coast Guard Spectrum Management Flow Chart for Proposals
