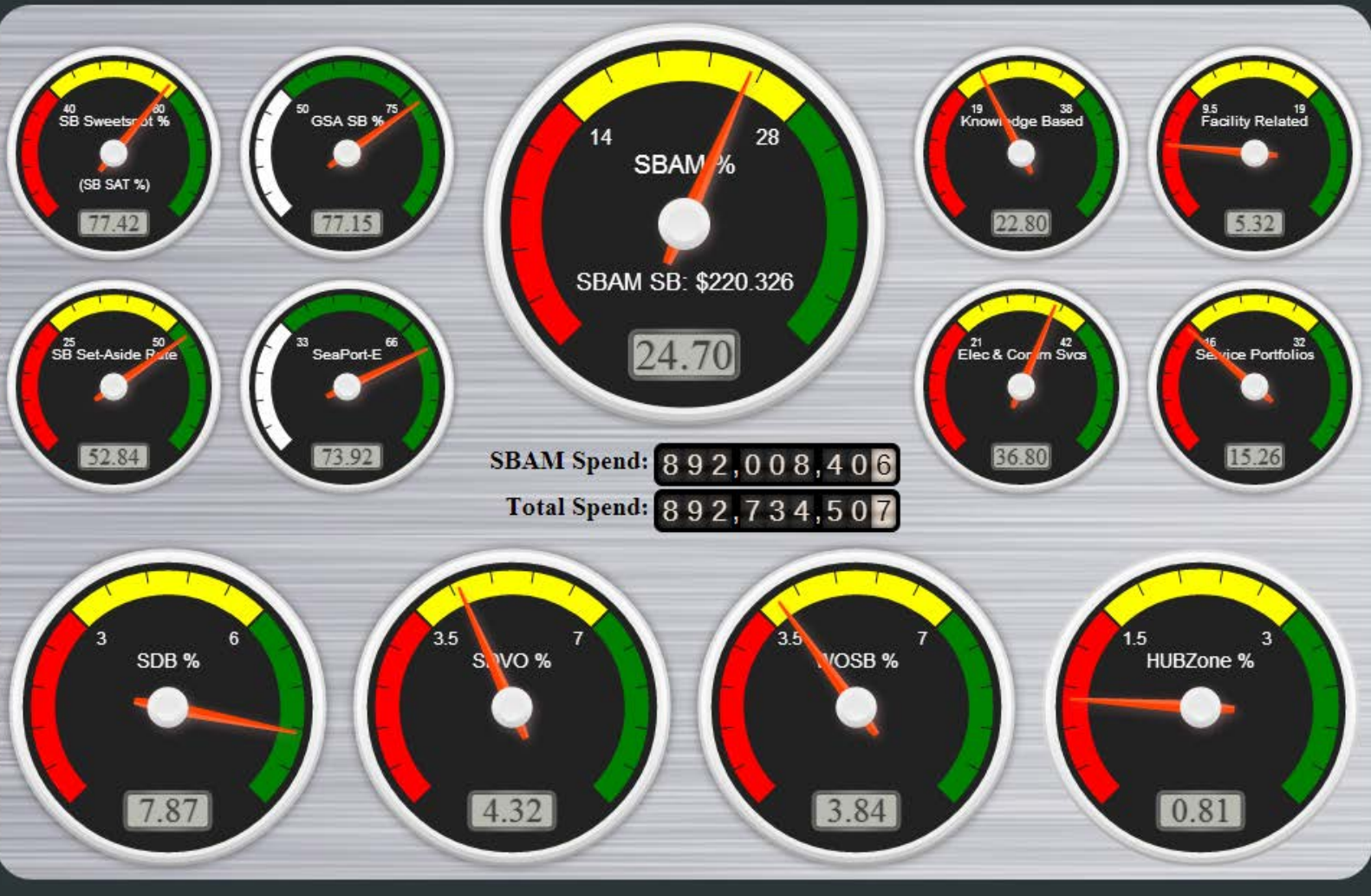

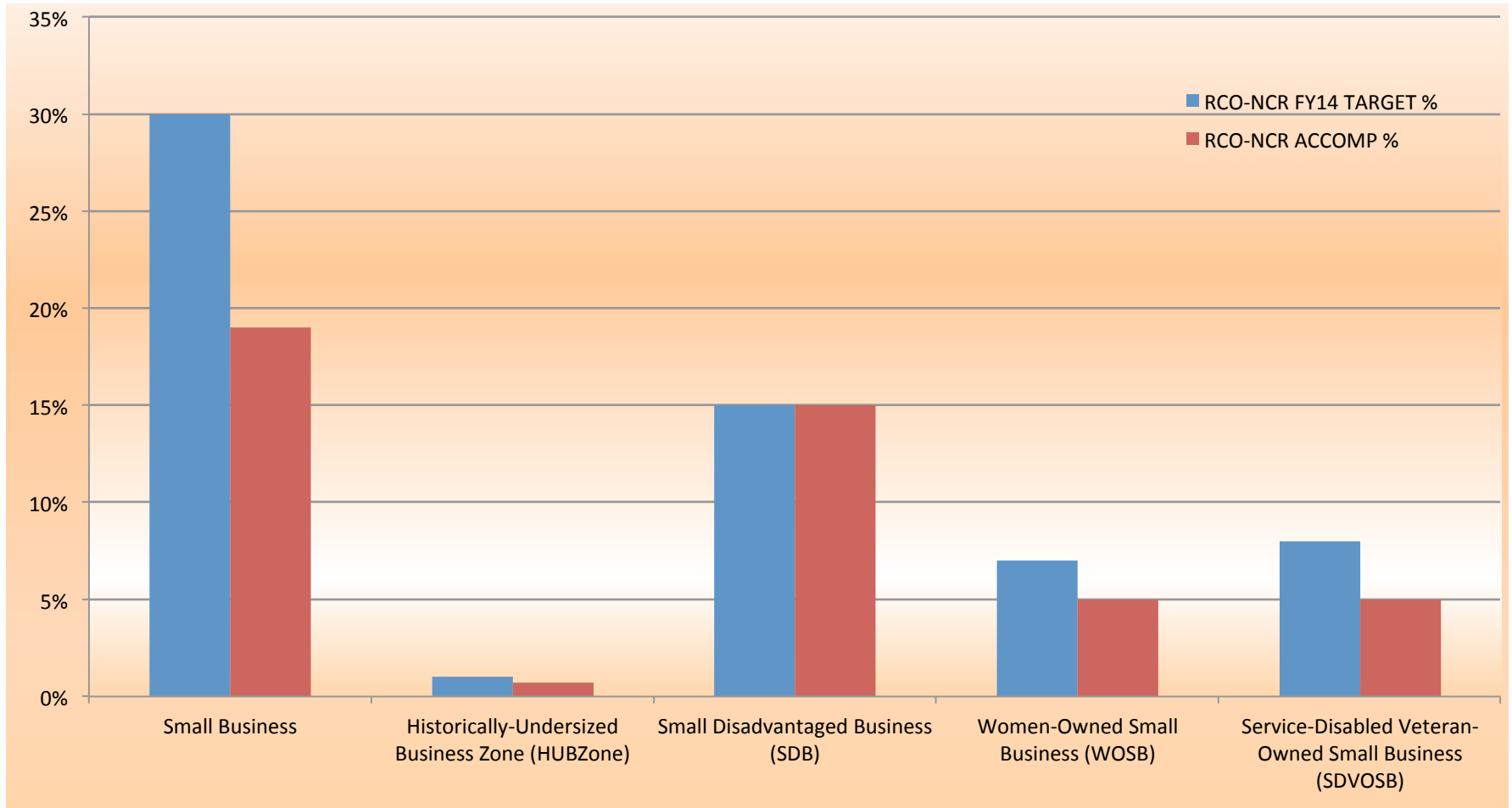

FY14 SB Dashboard HQMC, I&L *Data as of: 06 August 2014*



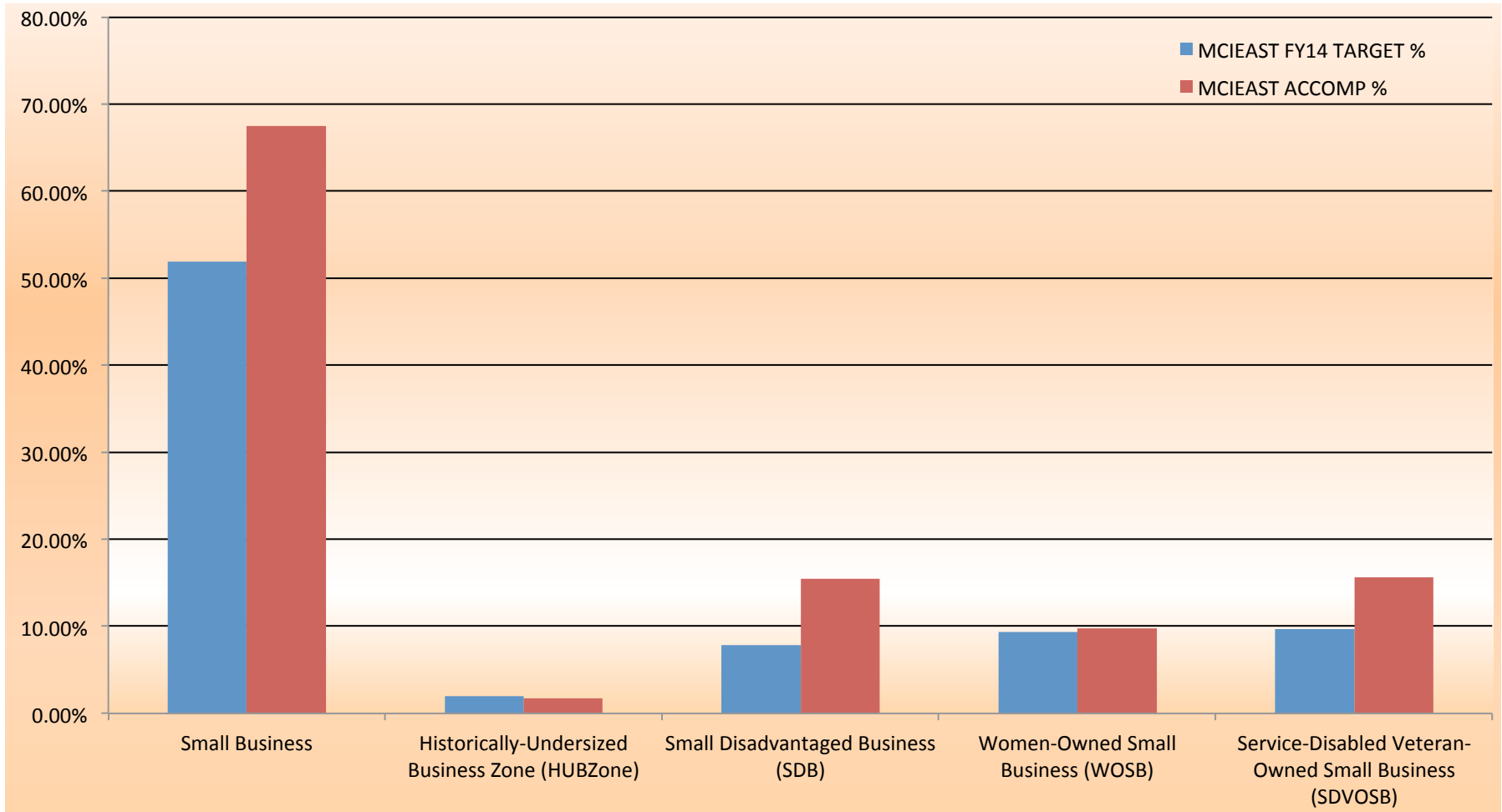


Marine Corps Installations Command (RCO-NCR)



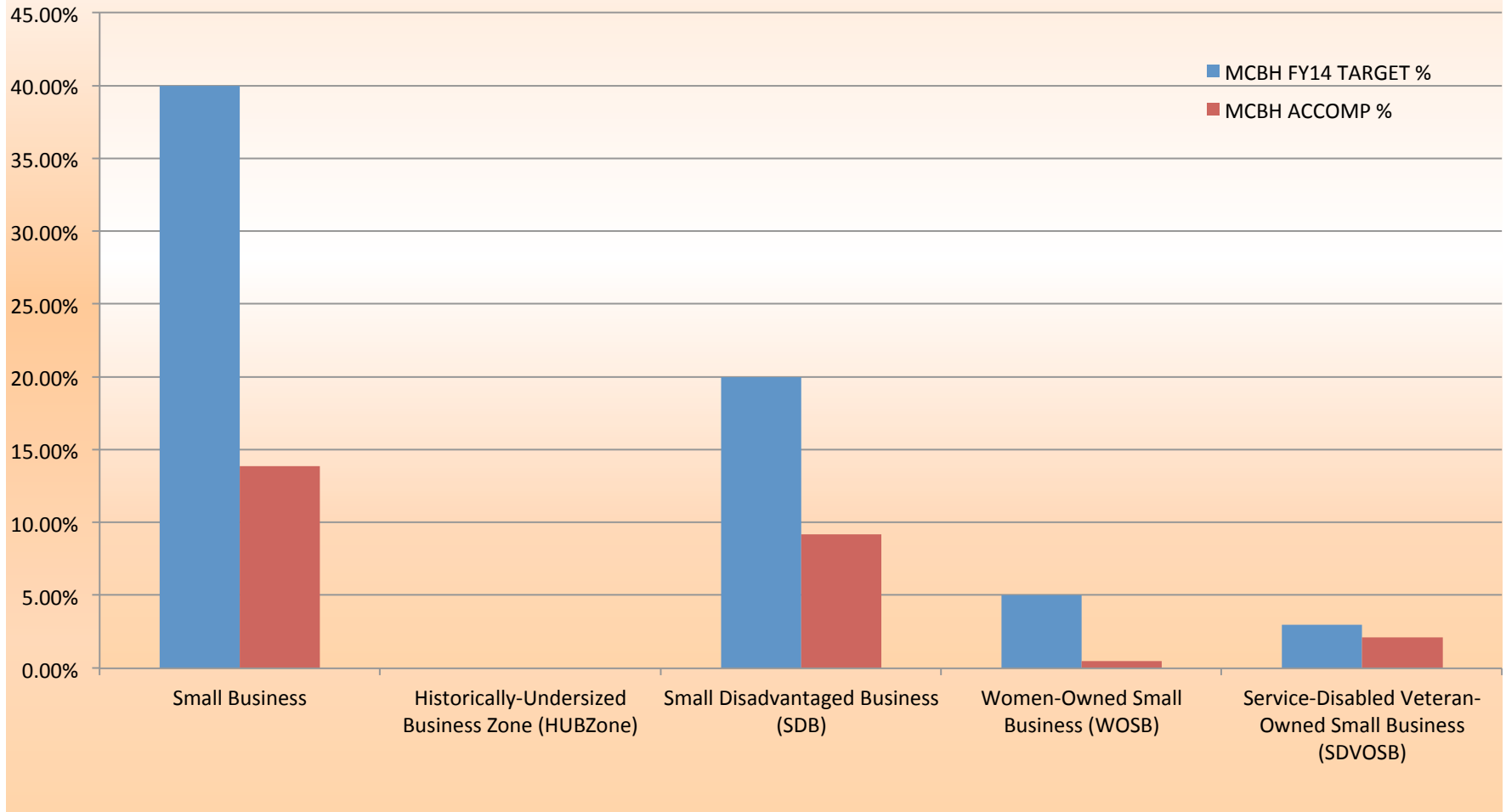


Marine Corps Installations Command (MCIEAST)



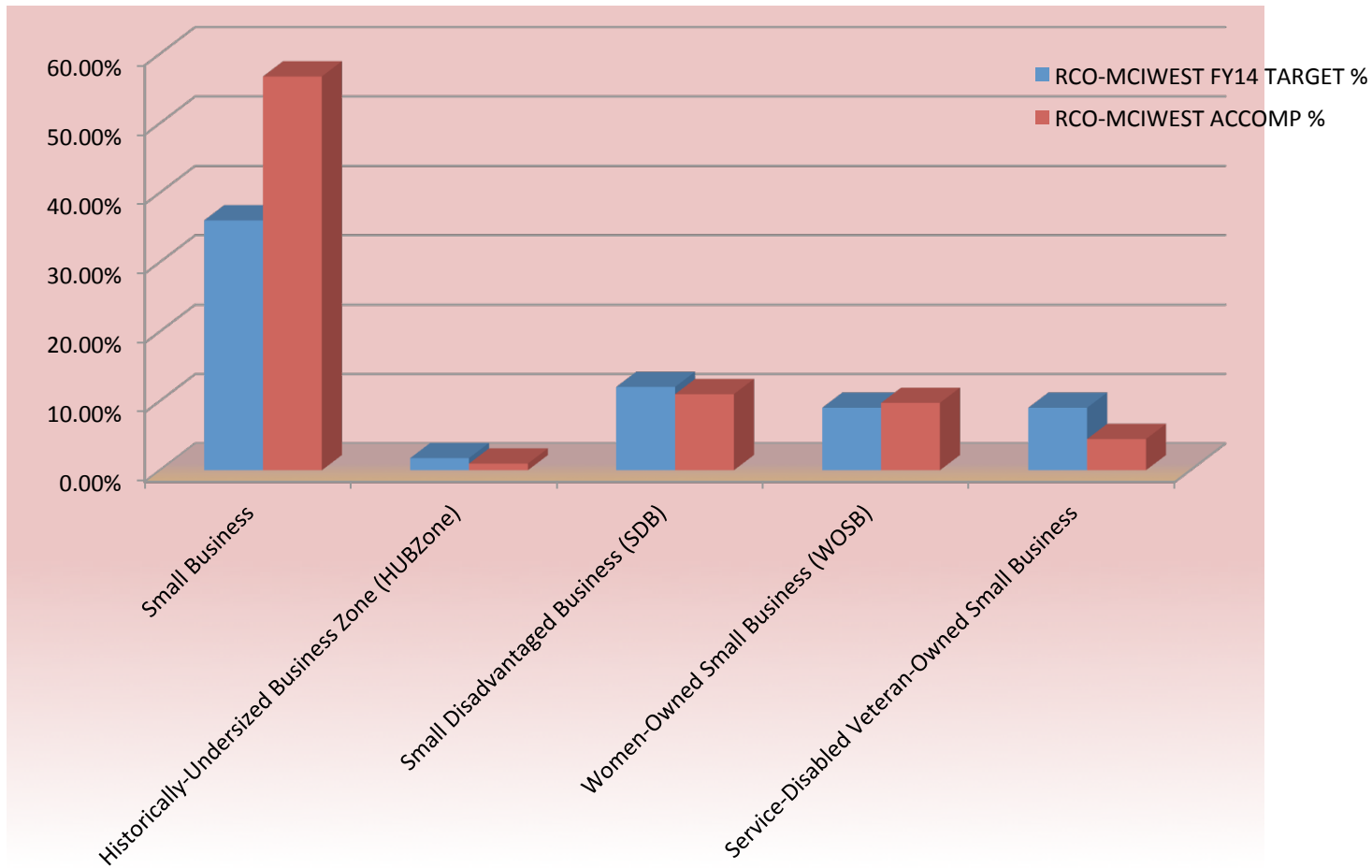


Marine Corps Installations Command (MCBH)



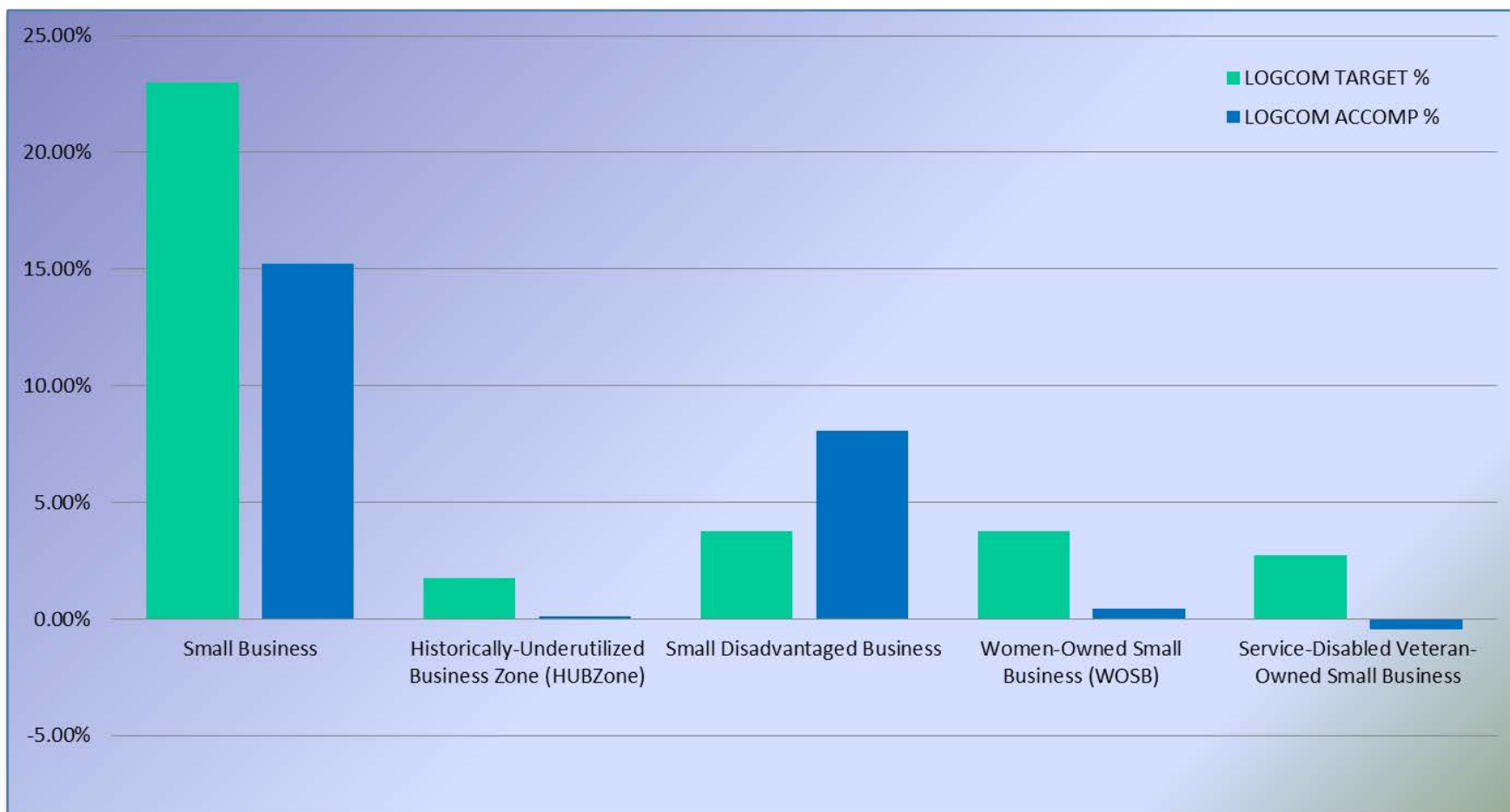
