APPROACH

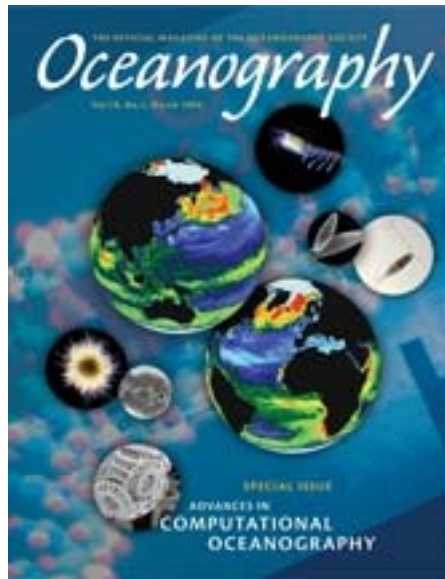
Activity A: Articles featuring several new and exciting ocean models and modeling approaches, as well as features forecasting future developments were included in this issue of *Oceanography*.

Activity B: This issue of *Oceanography* describes dramatic advances from the recent ONR-sponsored Japan/East Sea program.

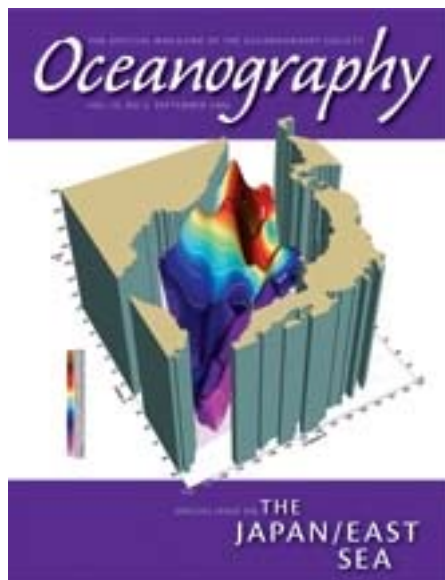
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WORK COMPLETED
